We hold rallies once a month, usually on the third Sunday from 1:30 to 2:30, to keep alive the message that people in Baltimore are working towards an anti-racist society. Our rallies are also a way to bring people together who are engaged in anti-racism work. In addition, each month we participate in a “related action” which involves donations of supplies and/or funds to Baltimore City organizations and schools.

***Since 2020, IC4BL has stood up to proclaim “Black Lives Matter!” Given the disproportionate effects ICE raids are having on Black and Brown communities, IC4BL is expanding our message and our actions to include immigrants, undocumented migrants and refugees. We welcome signs at our rallies that are interfaith and nonviolent. Suggested messages: “No Human Being is Illegal,” “Welcome Immigrants!” in addition to “All Lives Can’t Matter until Black and Brown Lives Matter!”***
