The rallies started shortly after the murder of George Floyd, when individuals in Baltimore wanted to do something and weren't sure how to direct their energy. The idea of monthly rallies was born! The purpose was to stand up for the Black community and lift up their voices, and be counted as allies.

We hold rallies once a month, usually on the third Sunday from 1:30 to 2:30, to keep alive the message that people in Baltimore are working towards an anti-racist society. Our rallies are also a way to bring people who share concerns together. In addition, each month we participate in a "related action" which involves donations of supplies and/or funds to Baltimore City organizations and schools. We will also continue to educate ourselves on issues and take action as appropriate.

We want to continue learning what other organizations are doing and support their efforts. Some of these organizations include: We Our Us, Baltimore Peace Movement and the ACLU.
