We hold rallies once a month, usually on the third Sunday from 1:30 to 2:30, to keep alive the message that people in Baltimore are working towards an anti-racist society. Our rallies are also a way to bring people together who are engaged in anti-racism work. In addition, each month we participate in a "related action" which involves donations of supplies and/or funds to Baltimore City organizations and schools.
