

Larsen Ridge Cabin Rules and Booking Summary

BOOKING SUMMARY

- The cabin costs \$25 per person per night
- Contact Skeena Valley Expeditions at (250) 615-3252 or cabins@SkeenaValleyExpeditions.com to book. The simplest method of payment is a credit card but alternatively you can write a check to Mount Remo Backcountry Society and mail to Skeena Valley Expeditions. Once payment is received a receipt will be given and your reservation will be confirmed.
- If you cancel your trip (even because of poor weather) a full refund is given less a \$25 administration fee.
- If you are unable to fly out and stay an extra night, you are expected to pay for the extra time there. This is not a punishment of any kind, it just plain costs money to keep the cabin stocked with supplies.
- The cabin sleeps 4 comfortably but you can squeeze up to 6 in.
- We do not take overlapping bookings to fill the cabin to capacity. When you book the cabin, regardless of group size, you book the whole cabin.
- We will give your name and contact info to other parties booking the cabin just before or after your trip so you can dovetail helicopter flights but ONLY if you request it. When you book, just give SVE your permission to pass out your contact info.

CABIN GUIDELINES, LOGISTICS, AND INFORMATION

This is a set of guidelines for you and your party to help us keep this cabin *clean, safe and enjoyable* for everyone to use.

Your group is responsible for arranging your own transportation in and out of the cabin.

Remember that the cabin is accessible only by helicopter:

- Quantum Helicopters 615-0168
- Canadian Helicopters 635-2430
- Lakelse Air 635-3245
- White River Helicopters 638-1414

Topographic Map (1:50,000 Scale):

- Map #: 103 – I/7 - *Lakelse Lake*
- UTM Coordinates: 516 800 E, 6 014 700 N
- Elevation: 1200m (4000 feet)

Remember you will be traveling in Avalanche Terrain & Bear Country!!!

In winter everyone in your party should be equipped with:

- *Avalanche Transceivers*
- *Probes*
- *Shovels*
- and the knowledge to use this equipment.

Maximum cabin occupancy is six (6) people.

Larsen Ridge Cabin Rules and Booking Summary

Cellular telephones usually do work from the cabin site. **A communication device is mandatory in order to be able to contact the helicopter company in the event of poor flying weather or in the case of an emergency.**

The Cabin is equipped with the following items:

- Wood stove with firewood underneath the trap door, (axe, kindling, matches).
- 3 burner propane stove
- Snow melting pot (2 X 32 litre) – there is NO source of water other than snow!
- Propane lantern (with mantels)
- Pots and pans
- Dishes and cutlery
- Dish soap and bleach
- Snow shovel

DO NOT forget that you need to supply your own:

- Sleeping bags
- Thermarests
- Toilet paper
- Newspaper

At the Cabin:

- NO smoking inside the cabin!!!
- No hunting from the cabin!!
- Use beige slop bucket under the sink for grey water and dump on the designated "Pee tree".
- NO dumping garbage down the outhouse !!
- NO burning garbage in the wood stove !!
- Do not split firewood inside the cabin or on the porch !!
- No outside shoes are allowed up in the loft !!

When you go out skiing or hiking:

- Make sure door is latched and windows are closed - an open door can lead to unwanted guests (critters) that can leave a big mess.
- Leave no fire unattended – ensure that the damper on the wood stove is closed.

When your Party leaves the Cabin:

- Cut kindling and bring in a small supply of firewood.
- All dishes, pots and pans are washed and put away upside down.
- Empty the snow melting pot.
- Windows are closed and latched.
- Sweep the floor and clean up.
- **DO NOT LEAVE ANY SPARE FOOD OF ANY KIND !!!**
- **ALL GARBAGE AND BOTTLES MUST BE PACKED OUT !!!**
- **TURN OFF PROPANE TO STOVE and the LANTERN !!!**
- **LATCH DOOR !!!**
- **SIGN the LOG BOOK !!!**

- If something may have broken and needs to be repaired or replaced.
