

Ever feel like your homeschool curriculum needs divine intervention?





Before sin entered the picture, Adam had the ultimate homeschool setup - face-to-face tutorials with the Creator Himself! No Pinterest-perfect classroom








White's educational philosophy suggests we should be raising independent thinkers, not "mere reflectors of other men's thought."


