The Apostolic Doctrine

Every ministry has fundamental beliefs that inspire worship. For us at Christ Temple, these fundamental beliefs form the doctrine that we adhere to. It is sometimes referred to as the Apostolic Doctrine. As profound and as fundamental as the doctrine is, it does not however supersede our relationship with the Lord. In other words we are not controlled by doctrine; instead, we are lead by the spirit of God and the promise of the Kingdom of God.

Our earnest expectation is to live holy lives acceptable unto the Lord. Ultimately we want to be found worthy at His return. This core belief is our guide to that promise.

The Bible is the inspired Word of God

II Timothy 3:26

There is only one God, creator of man, heaven and earth

Genesis 1:1, Rev. 4:11

Jesus is the one true God (incarnate) in the flesh.

John 1:1-14, I Timothy 3:16

We believe that repentance from sin is required by God and is necessary for forgiveness of sin. Further, we believe in Water Baptism by immersion in the Name of the Lord Jesus Christ for the **remission of our sins**. Matthew 1:21, Romans 6:4-7, Acts 2:36-41

Salvation from sin is in Jesus Christ alone and requires the living of a Holy life.
