## **RECREATIONAL RULES**

- You may set the serve. Underhand hits can be open-handed as long as the ball is not caught or thrown.
- 1st Team listed serves games 1 & 3. **RALLY SCORING TO 25.** You must win by two points with a 27 point cap. When time is called, the team ahead wins.
- Each team will play 3 games – no matter who wins the first two. Standings are based on the number of games won by each team. The team with the most wins will be league champion. You must play the final night in order to win the league (even though you may have enough wins without play). In case of ties, there will be a one game playoff the last night of league play to 15. All teams are responsible in reporting the game results.
- First game will be a forfeit if 10 minutes late to court, 2 games after 15 minutes and 3 games after 20 minutes.
- You may play with a minimum of 4 players and a maximum of 6. There does not have to be equal number of men or women on a team; however, at no time, can there be more than 3 men on the court.
- No more than 2 spectators may sub on one team at a time. These subs should be at the same level as the other team members. All subs should be added to your roster. No new players or subs are allowed the last night of the league. **POWER/INTERMEDIATE PLAYERS MAY NOT SUB ON REC TEAM.**
- Any contact with the net during play results in a side out or point for the other team. This applies to both recreational and intermediate teams. Please call your own violations.
- A player may cross under the net as long as they do not interfere with the other team's opportunity to play the ball.
- Back row players may not attack or block the ball within 10 feet of the net.
- You may not block or spike the serve. The ball may be played with any part of the body.
- "LET SERVE" is allowed.
- If you have a disagreement about a call–replay the point. Coordinator has the final say in disagreements or rule interpretations.
- All other general volleyball rules apply.
