Figure 1. CNAs: Length of Time With Current Employer, in Years

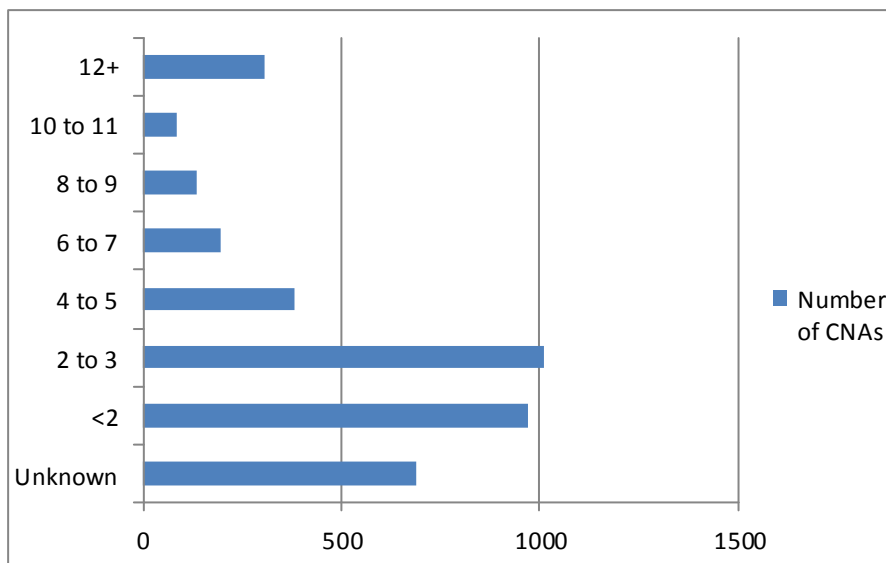

Figure 2. CNAs: Highest Degree Earned

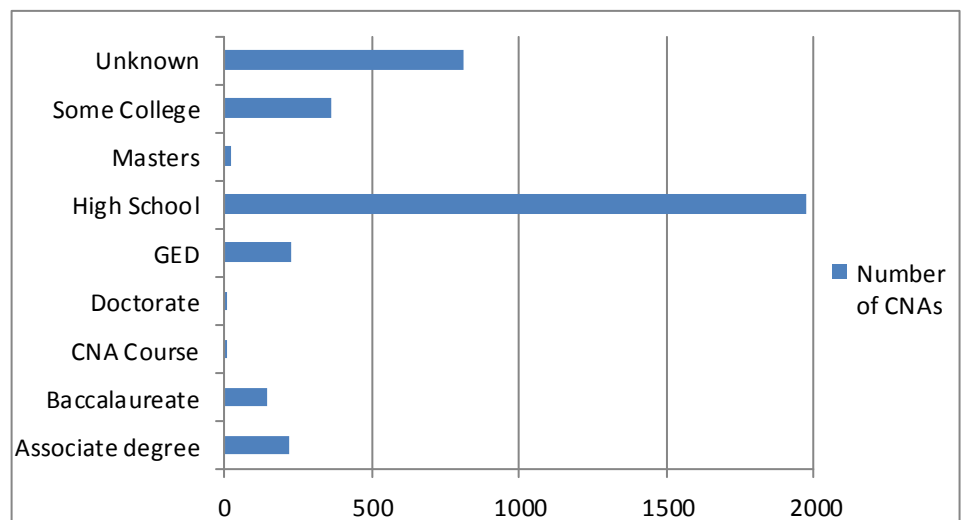

Figure 4. CNAs: Age

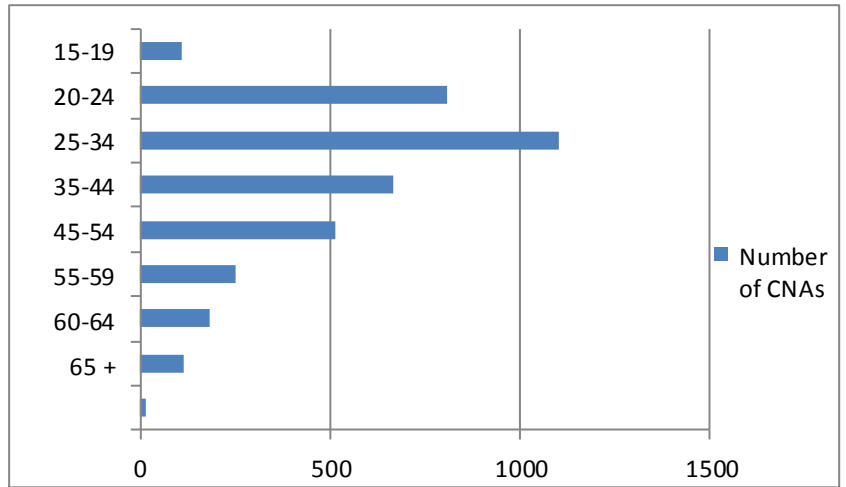


Figure 5. CNAs: Gender

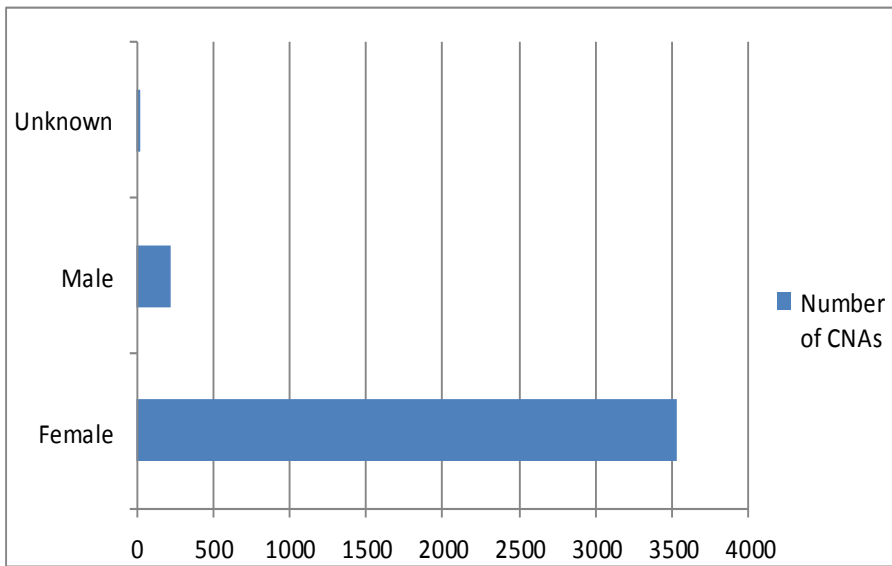
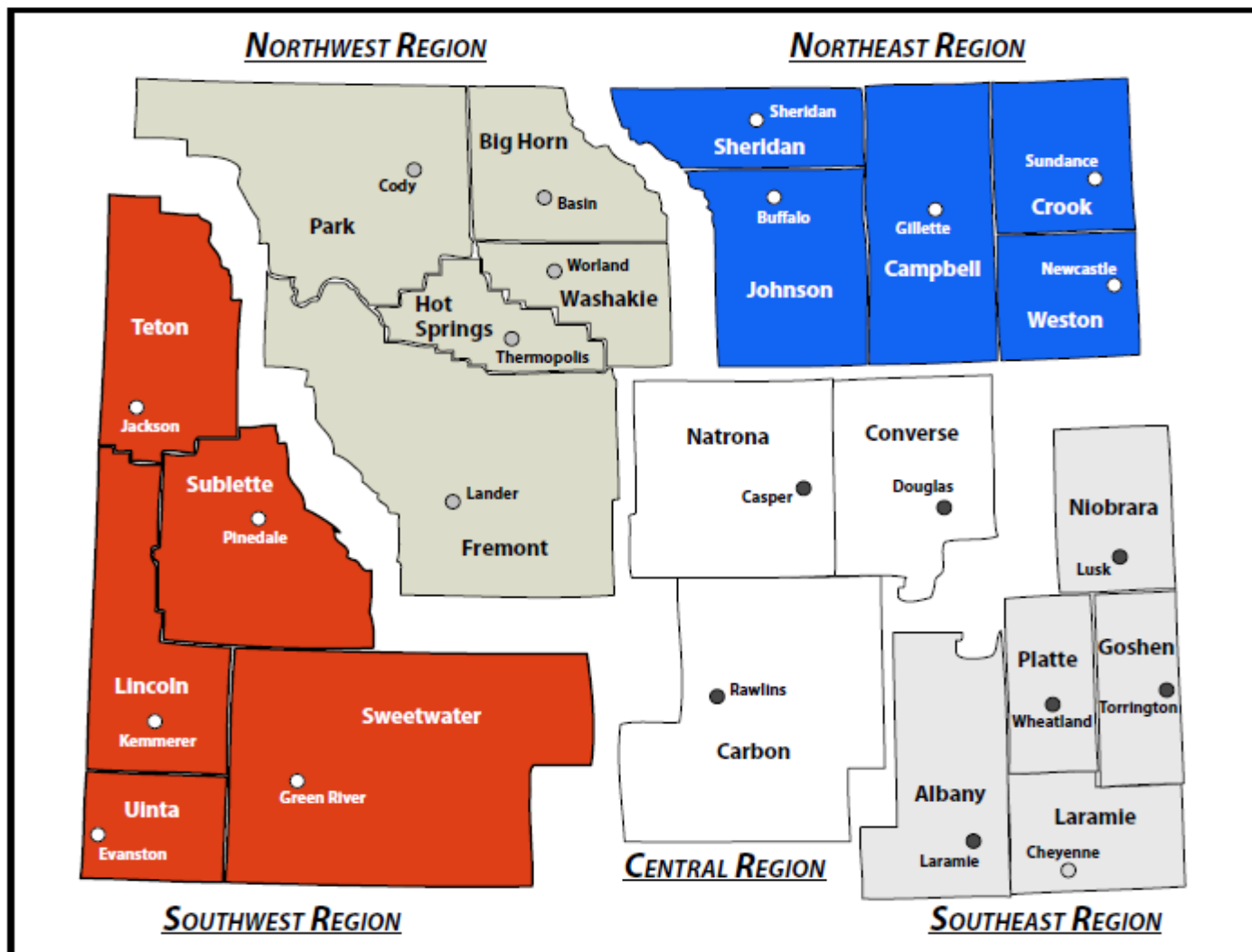
