Zoom meeting was initiated.

- President's Report
 - 501c3 paperwork has been approved
 - EIN has been given until tax exempt has come in

Basketball court update:

- Concrete quote was \$24,000 AFTER waived labor cost
- It was suggested by the attendees to do a half court

 - Asking Deer Creek Foundation to partner with the school to find a donor
 - Finding someone to sponsor the goals
- No specific timeline for completion of basketball court

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Principal's Report

Glow in the Dark fun run:

- Booster funds go to several projects; basketball court, technology fees
- Goal was \$25,000
- Total raised was \$14,500
- Losses include:
 - Booster's fees and \$2,000 spent on t-shirts.
- There may be a fundraiser again in the spring.
- Learning is virtual on 11/17, followed by a week for Thanksgiving break.
- December events:
 - Second grade musical on 12/14
 - Winter party on 12/15
 - Setup is moved to 2:40pm with party times being 2:45pm to 3:15pm.
 - Party times changed to allow for parents to move vehicles before pick up starts.
 - Lots of congestion for the fall party
 - A new map for parking will be sent out before the winter party
 - Bus lanes must be kept clear
- January events:
 - First day back is 1/4.
 - PTO meeting is 1/16 at 4pm.
- Veteran's Day parade was a success and enjoyed by the kids.
