- In-Cab Safety Belt** Apply Safety Belt

 - Safe Start Procedure** Brakes Applied, Bus in Neutral, Turn key to on position, Safely start Bus

 - ABS & DEF Lights Check** Turn the key to accesory, lights on Dash board came on and off in 5 seconds, working properly

 - Air Brake Check** Build air pressure to between 120 & 140 psi or governor cut off.

 - Governor cut off,** proper range working properly

 - Air Brake leak test** Shut off engine, turn key back to on position

 - You should not lose more than** 3 psi in one minute

 - Press and hold brake pedal (don't stomp on pedal)** Push in yellow (valve)

 - Wait for air to stabilize** Start your one minute timer

 - One minute has passed** I did not lose more than 3 psi in 1 minute working properly

 - Low air Alarm check** Alarm will come on at 55 psi or above

 - Alarm came on __psi, proper range working properly

13. **Spring brake test** Spring brake come on between 20 to 45 psi

14. **Continue to Fan
your brakes until
valve pops out** Spring brake popped out ___ psi,
proper range working properly

15. **Parking Brake
Check** Build Air Pressure to at least 90 psi

16. **Put Truck in drive,** Truck did not move, bus brake is working properly

17. **Service Brake
Test, release
brake** Pull forward to 5 mph, Come to a Smooth and Complete stop, Wheel Did not Pull
Left or Right

18. **Light Indicators
Check** Left and Right Turn Signals, 4 way Flashers, High and Low Beams Working Properly

19. **Emergency
Equipment Check**

- There is a charged and secure Fire Extinguisher,
- 6 spare fuses,
- 3 Reflective Triangles or Flares

20. **Windshield and
Mirrors Check**

- Both Securely mounted
- Not broken not cracked or flawed glass
- Clean and Clear with no obstructions
- Mirrors adjusted to me the driver

21. **Wipers and
Washers Check** Arms and Blades

- Both securely mounted

- Not broken or cracked not dry rotted
- Washers Work and Squirt

22. **Heater and Defroster Check**

Turn Heater on to heat, blows top and bottom, Working Properly

23. **Horn Check**

Push city horn with at least 90 psi, Pull the Country (Air) Horn, Working Properly

24. **Light Operations Check, ask examiner to help you**

Lights front of vehicle. Turn signals, 4 ways, clearance, low and high beams

25. **Lenses front of vehicle**

- Securely Mounted
- Not cracked, broken
- Not missing
- Proper color
- Clean and clear

26. **Fluid Levels Check**

Coolant and Power Steering Reservoir

- Securely Mounted
- Not cracked, broken, leaking
- Proper Level no leaks

27. **Oil Dipstick Check**

- Securely Mounted
- Not cracked, broken or leaking
- (Explain) pull Dipstick out, clean it, replace it, pull back out • Proper Level

28. **Fluid and Air leaks**

Engine and Transmission

- Both securely Mounted
- Hoses No cuts, tears, bulges, Leaks
- No visible leaks, no audible leaks

29. **Steering System Check**

Gear box and 5 pcs Steering Linkage

- Both securely Mounted

- Not cracked, broken, gear box not leaking
 - Arms and Rods, joints not lose or worn
 - No missing hardware

30. Tires Check

- Securely Mounted to the rim, inside, outside, and top
 - No cuts, tears, bulges, Leaks
 - No exposed wires
 - Tread depth 4/32 or more, tire tread guage
 - Proper inflation, pressure guage
-

31. Valve Stem

- Securely Mounted
 - Not broken, not cracked, no Leaks
 - Cap present and tight
-

32. Lug Nuts and Studs Check

- Securely Mounted
 - Not broken, not cracked
 - No missing hardware
 - No shinny threads and rust trails
-

33. Leaf Springs, Mounts, U-bolts, Shock Absorber

- Securely mounted
 - Not broken or cracked
 - No missing hardware and tight
 - Springs aren't shifted, Shocks not Leaking
-

34. Brake Lines and Hoses

- Securely mounted
 - Clamps are present and tight
 - No cuts, tears, bulges, leaks
 - Supplies air to the brakes
-

35. Brake Contaminates

- Brakes and Drums
- Securely mounted
 - Not broken or cracked
 - No contaminates, oil or grease between brakes and drum

36. **Side Of Vehicle Lenses and Reflectors**
- Securely mounted
 - Not broken or cracked or missing
 - Clean and Clear
 - Proper color
-

37. **Mirrors and brackets**
- Securely mounted
 - Not broken or cracked
 - Clean and Clear
 - No missing hardware
-

38. **Battery**
- Battery box opens and closes
- Batteries, cables, and terminals
 - Securely mounted
 - Not broken or cracked
 - Cables aren't worn, no corrosion
-

39. **Fuel and Def tanks**
- Securely mounted
 - Not broken or cracked
 - No leaks from tank, caps, or hoses
 - Caps are tight and sealed
-

40. **Frames and Crossmembers**
- Securely mounted
 - Not broken or cracked or broken welds
 - No missing hardware or crossmembers
 - No holes in the floor of cargo box
-

41. **Reflective tape back and side of Truck**
- Securely mounted
 - Not broken or cracked
 - Adhered to Bus
 - Proper color red and silver
