While the club was busy getting things done and having fun. President Trump and his administration have been focused on healthcare, financial regulation, and foreign policy.

- **Settling the IRS Lawsuit & Creating an "Anti-Weaponization" Fund:**

The Justice Department dropped the president's \$10 billion lawsuit against the government regarding past tax leaks. In exchange, the administration established a \$1.8 billion fund designed to compensate

individuals who claim they were unfairly targeted by previous administrations.

- **High-Stakes Summit with China:** President Trump traveled to Beijing for a high-level summit with Chinese President Xi Jinping to address trade, semiconductor regulations, and regional tensions.
- **Financial Deregulation:** Issued new executive orders aimed at integrating financial technology (fintech) into regulatory frameworks and issued directives focused on "restoring integrity" to the U.S. financial system.
- **Healthcare & Maternal Health Events:** Participated in multiple high-profile events centered on maternal healthcare and overall healthcare affordability.
- **Jewish American Heritage Month:** Signed a presidential proclamation declaring May 2026 as Jewish American Heritage Month to honor the contributions of Jewish Americans.
- **White House Construction Updates:** Gained approval from the Commission of Fine Arts for the construction of a new 250-foot triumphal arch on the White House grounds.
- **Rededicate 250: A National Day of Prayer, Praise and Thanksgiving:** The event aimed to reunite the country under the phrase "One Nation Under God" to honor the nation's faith-based roots ahead of America's upcoming 250th anniversary.

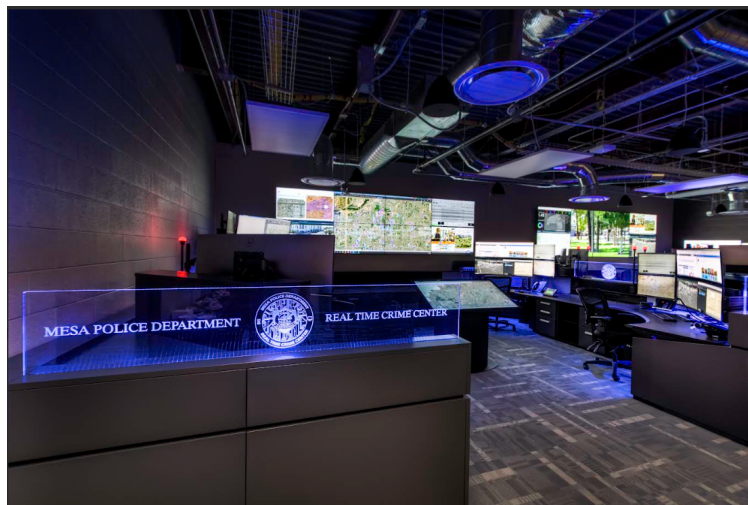
