Pam Kirby

As the **President and Founder of The Arizona Coalition of School Board Members**, Pam will outline the crisis facing government schools, who is really to blame, and how parents and other stakeholders can stay a step ahead of the Left's tactics in 2026.

Pam Kirby is an education and finance leader committed to helping Arizona's schools serve students effectively and transparently. A retired CPA with executive experience at Fortune 500 companies, she also served two terms on both the Paradise Valley Town Council and the Scottsdale School District Governing Board. Pam is the President and Founder of The Arizona Coalition of School Board Members, a national trailblazing 501(c)(3) organization dedicated to providing training and resources to conservative school board members, along with its sister organizations, Friends of the Coalition (c)(4) and Students First PAC, which support conservative school board candidates across Arizona. She holds an MBA and a Master's in Education Policy and is currently pursuing a Graduate Certificate in Education Finance from Georgetown University. www.azcoalition.org

As our **Maricopa County School Superintendent**, Shelli will provide a real-time view of the direction public education across the county is headed if misplaced administrative priorities continue to fail. She will share both progress and challenges as she continues working to keep politics out of the classroom and achieve excellence at the forefront.

Superintendent Shelli Boggs is a dedicated public servant, experienced educator, and the Maricopa County School Superintendent. With over two decades of leadership in education, she brings a results-driven, student-first approach to the office. In her role, Superintendent Boggs is responsible for overseeing school governing board elections, managing school finance, appointing members to fill school board vacancies, and maintaining homeschool and private school records. She also oversees the Maricopa County Regional School District, which encompasses detention education and the Hope Accommodation School. Superintendent Boggs is committed to restoring excellence in education by empowering parents, supporting teachers, and ensuring fiscal responsibility. Rachel Walden

As **Commissioner and Mesa Public Schools Governing Board Member**, Rachel will explain why school choice strengthens—not weakens—public schools and makes them better. She shares what it takes to sustain success in Arizona's largest district to remain viable as she prepares for another term.

Rachel Walden has lived in Arizona since she was a child. Mrs. Walden and her husband are lifelong Republicans and are raising their daughter in Mesa. She currently serves as a member of the Mesa Public Schools Governing Board, the largest school district in the state. As a Governing member she has prioritized academic achievement, parental rights, fiscal responsibility, and transparency. A resolute public servant, she was elected to the Corporation Commission in November 2024 and continues to be an advocate for rate payers, especially in the green project fight. Mrs. Walden holds a BS degree with honors from Arizona State University. She continued at ASU in a Master of Arts program (ABD), during which she was hired by the University as a Teaching Assistant and Research Assistant and was a fellowship recipient. Raised by a hard-working single mother in a family of 5 children, her mother was a self-employed financial planner. Steve Smith

As **Executive Director of the TW Lewis Foundation** and one of the original architects of Arizona's Empowerment Scholarship Accounts (ESA) program, Steve will set the record straight on the facts behind the program and how to push back against false media narratives.

Steve Smith currently serves as the Executive Director of the TW Lewis Foundation supporting dozens of local and national Christian/conservative non-profit organizations. Previously, he was the Director for the American Federation for Children and was featured nationally as one of the top leaders in K-12 education for his work in helping to implement school choice in Arizona and across the country with the Universal ESA program. Steve is best known for his work in the Legislature when in 2010 he was elected as one of the youngest Senators in Arizona's history. He served 8 years and was the Chairman of the powerful Commerce and Public Safety and Military Committees. Recipient of numerous lifetime achievement awards, Mr. Smith was ranked as the #1 conservative Legislator in Arizona by every top scorecard. He was named 'Friend of the Family' for his 100% pro-life and religious freedom record and was Legislator of the Year for his work for the disabled community. Most notably though, Steve authored the original 'build the border fence' legislation in 2012 and was a leading national figure on the effort to secure the border.
