Rep. Andy Biggs

In a March 2025 congressional hearing, Rep. Andy Biggs (AZ-5) grilled sanctuary city mayors over immigration policies that he says “invite lawlessness” by allowing illegal immigrants to remain in the U.S.

“You’re allowing them to stay in America. Your policies have created an open invitation for cartels and traffickers. Meanwhile, communities along the border are bearing the brunt of the crime, the fentanyl, and the chaos that follow.”

Sanctuary city policies undermine federal immigration enforcement. Immediate policy changes are needed to protect border communities. Cartel activity and drug trafficking are being fueled by policy gaps.

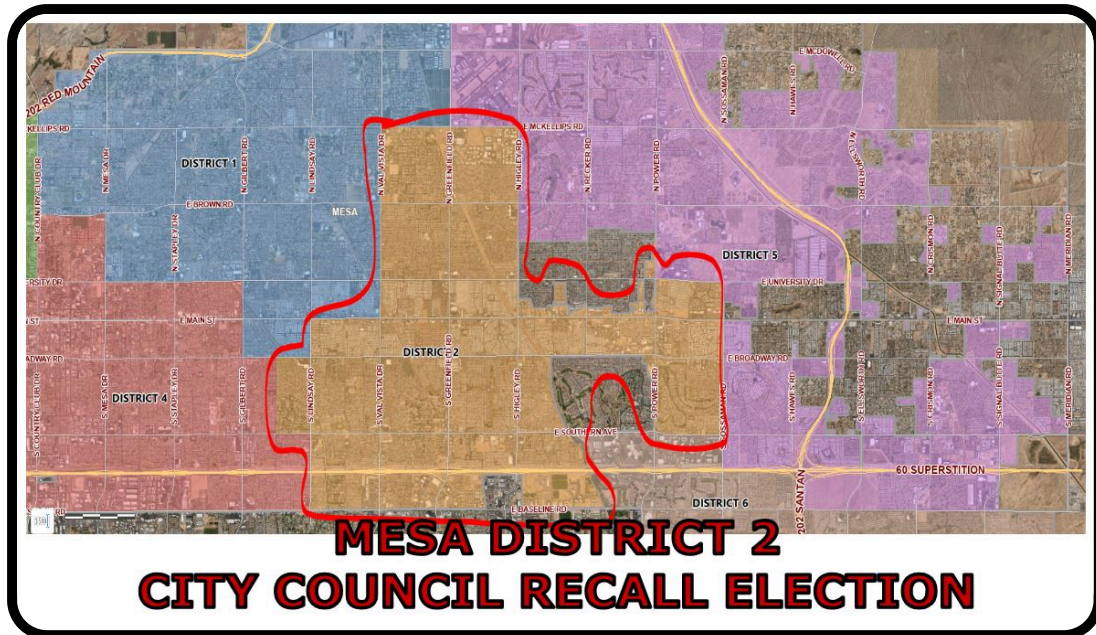

🗳️ **Special Recall Election in Mesa District 2 — Mark Your Calendar for November 4th!**

Mesa voters will head to the polls for a **Special Recall Election** in **City Council District 2**, taking place on **Tuesday, November 4, 2025**. This election comes in response to a certified citizen-led petition to recall current Councilmember **Julie Spilsbury**.


The recall effort stems from **growing community concerns** around recent council decisions and how they align with district priorities. Among the cited reasons:

- ✓ Voted to **raise utility rates** (Ordinances 5832–5838)
- ✓ Voted to **increase council salaries** (Ordinance 5840)
- ✓ Supported converting a hotel into a **social service facility for temporary homeless housing** (Ordinance 5817)

With **over 3,800 verified signatures**, voters have officially triggered the election. Councilmember Spilsbury has confirmed she **will run again** in the recall to retain her seat. The winning candidate—whether her or a challenger—will serve the remainder of the term through **January 2029**.

📍 **Who Votes:** Registered voters in **District 2**
📅 **Election Day:** **Tuesday, November 4, 2025**

This election gives residents a direct say in the direction of city leadership. **Whether you're seeking change or satisfied with current representation, your vote matters.**

 MRW will invite confirmed candidates to speak at an upcoming meeting once the filing deadline passes later in August.

If you or someone in your household **owns property in Mesa**, you are eligible to vote in the **critical Salt River Project (SRP) elections** happening **April 7, 2026**—but **you must register in advance** to receive your early ballot.

 **This is a critical local election for conservatives in 2026.**

 **46 seats are up for grabs**, including board and council positions that control **energy rates, water access, infrastructure projects, and long-term power planning**.

 **Only landowners can vote**, and with voter turnout historically under 2%, **just a handful of votes can swing entire districts**.

 **Why it matters to conservatives:**

SRP is one of the last major utilities **not fully captured by extreme green energy mandates**. If we lose control of the board, we risk following in the footsteps of APS—where progressive leadership has pushed costly “green new scam” policies, triggering **significant rate hikes** for families and small businesses. SRP is already under pressure from climate activists. **We must hold the line.**

 **Key Timeline:**

Mid 2025 – Early ballot registration window opens (registration required)

October 2025 – Candidate forum & official list released

April 7, 2026 – Election Day
