SUBJECT: Advice on Disposition of Court-Martial Charges, US v. 1LT Mark Bashaw, Headquarters and Headquarters Company, United States Army Public Health Center, United States Army Medical command, Aberdeen Proving Ground, MD 21010

- 1.I have reviewed the charges and allied papers in the case of Mark Bashaw, and render this advice in accordance with the provisions of Article 34, UCMJ, and Rule for Courts-Martial 406.
- 2. Legal Conclusions. After reviewing the attached charges and allied papers, I have reached the following legal conclusions:
 - a. Each specification alleges an offense under the UCMJ;
- b. There is court-martial jurisdiction over the accused and the offenses.
- c. The allegations in the charge and each specification are warranted by the facts and the evidence provides probable cause to believe that the accused committed the offense charged in each specification.
- 3. No Article 32 preliminary hearing conducted.
- 4. The Company Commander recommended trial by Special Courts-Martial consisting of a military judge alone. The Garrison Commander recommended the misconduct be referred to a General Officer Article 15 proceeding.
- 5. Staff Judge Advocate Recommendation: I recommend the charged offenses be tried by a Special Courts-Martial consisting of a military judge alone pursuant to UCMJ, Article 16(c)(2)(A) in the interests of justice and discipline.
