- Titanium White (4 oz.)
- Alizarin Crimson (4 oz.)
- Bone Black (4 oz.)
- Ultramarine Blue (4 oz.)

- Beeswax
- Cobalt drier (siccative)
- Carborundum
- Glass muller (medium size)
- 1/4 in. plate glass (12 x12 in)
- Spatulas
- Plastic putty knife
- Rubber shelf liner
- Squeeze bottles
- NIOSH-approved particle mask
- Protective eyewear
- Nitrile gloves
- Mineral spirits
- Craft paper (for covering the work surface)
- Drafting tape
