SEPTEMBER 6TH & 7TH, 2019

1. The Backyard Barbeque Cook Off is a contest for **AMATURE COOKERS**.
2. Awards will be announced at the **STAGE at 3:30 PM** or as soon as possible.
3. Cookers must be in **ALL 3** categories **PORK, CHICKEN, and RIBS** to be eligible for **Grand Champion** and **Reserve Champion**.
4. Meat inspections will be **as soon as you arrive**.
5. Meat **shall not be** marinated or rubs applied or injected before inspected. Pre-trimming is allowed.
6. **A MANDATORY COOKS MEETING will be held at 5:30 pm Friday night**. We will go over the *rules and to answer any questions about the cook-off*.
7. During set up times, vehicles may enter the BBQ area for unloading
8. **ONLY 1 vehicle per cook team in cook area**. All others will be towed at owner's expense.
9. Desserts will be judged at **8:00pm Friday night**.
10. Contest entrees must be submitted in a {9"x9"} numbered styro foam tray provided . Each tray will contain at least **6 identifiable pieces of meat** (garnish optional). If used, garnish is **ACCORDING TO KCBS RULES without** decorations or markings.
11. Contest entrees will be turned in at **judges tent**, CHICKEN **12:00 PM**, RIBS at **12:30 PM**, and PORK at **1:00 PM**. Entrees must be turned in no sooner than 5 minutes before and no later than 5 minutes after each turn in time, according to the representatives clock to be judged in each division. Participants are allowed to use any type of sauces.
12. Fires shall be of wood, wood pellets or charcoal. Gas and electric heat sources shall not be permitted for cooking or holding. Electric is permitted as a fire starter, provided that competition meat is not in/on device. Electrical devices such as spits, augers, and forced draft are permitted. No open pits or holes are permitted. Fires shall not be built on the ground.
13. Contestants shall provide all needed equipment and supplies.
14. Safety at this event is paramount. Any unsafe acts or safety issues identified by a Fire on the Mountain Rep will be immediately corrected. Failure to follow the Fire on the Mountain Rep may cause removal from the grounds. Contestants must adhere to all fire and safety codes. A fire extinguisher shall be near all cooking devices.
15. **TEAMS** will be responsible for cleaning up your space. **DO NOT DUMP GREASE, LIQUID, OR HOT COALS** in trash cans or on the grounds, receptacles will be provided. There will be metal 55 gallon drums for the coals.

16. Persons 18 years and older are eligible to compete in the cook off competition.
17. No commercial vending or solicitation allowed in the competition.
18. No parboiling and/or deep-frying competition will be allowed.
19. **This is a family event**, and while we do not condone drinking, we do realize it is going to happen. No labeled bottles or cans should be seen. **ANY** alcohol will **ONLY** be allowed in unmarked cups. Please do not over indulge.
