Membership Structure

If you are 18 or older and identify as autistic, you are welcome to join us. We do not charge any membership dues at this time.

Event Fees

Fees for activities will be posted on our website. Depending on the club's financial situation, some events may be available at a discounted rate to make them more accessible. For instance, if an event costs us \$30, we may charge \$15, with the club covering the additional costs. Please keep in mind that discounted fees depend on the available funding and may not always be offered.

Communication

We keep our members updated through newsletters, emails, social media, and our website, sharing information about upcoming events and important announcements. Sign up for our newsletter and you will be notified of events as they are posted on our website.

Rules for Attending

1. Respectful Behavior

Members are expected to treat each other with kindness and respect. Disruptive or inappropriate behavior may result in warnings or expulsion from the club.

2. Participation

Members are encouraged to actively engage in events and discussions. Your involvement helps foster a sense of community and belonging.

3. RSVP Policy

We require members to sign up for events in advance to assist with planning and logistics. Failing to attend without prior notice may affect your ability to participate in future events.

4. Assistance Guidelines

If you require assistance during events, please bring a support person with you. Our site coordinators are not equipped to provide personal assistance, so please do not drop off individuals needing support without prior arrangements. Site coordinators focus solely on coordinating group activities.

5. Refund Policy

Some events may require tickets to be purchased in advance. Members should be aware of any associated fees upfront. Please note that we do not issue refunds for cancellations, as we pay for your tickets in advance and reserve spots that could have been filled by others.
