Prof. Guy Jaouen, President of ITSGA has convened a meeting of people concerned in the mission of development of traditional sports and games in the region for the creation of ATSGA and an ad-hoc committee to prepare this creation.

Prof. Guy Jaouen, President ITSGA in his opening remarks welcomed all the participants and thanked them to spare their precious time for this noble cause of formation of ad-hoc committee for creation of Asian Traditional Sports and Games Association (ATSGA).

He introduced himself to the participants formally and asked the members to share their background to all the participants. Every delegate has briefed about their expertise in Physical education, sports sciences and informed about their organizational experiences. After the speaking in of Mr Neeraj Kumar Mehra about Indigenous games, President Jaouen clarified the following point: the expression TSG is a dialectic compromise. For example the Pan American organisation is called APJDAT that is (in English) Panamerican Association for

indigenous and traditional sports and games. The Asian organization could also put forwards such ideas.

Prof. Guy Jaouen, President, ITSGA and Chairman of the meeting asked Prof. Syed Sakhawat Ali to note the proceedings of the meeting as a volunteer.

Prof. Guy Jaouen, President ITSGA briefed the house about the history and development of TSG program under ITSGA and its continental organizations.

Prof. Dr. Pere Lavega, President, AEJeST and Vice President, ITSGA briefed the house about the achievements of European TSG and its member organizations.

Prof. Guy Jaouen, President, ITSGA gone through the agenda items point to point. He also appreciated Mr. B K Bharat, Convener from India to coordinate in the organizing of this meeting and to finalize the list of delegates for this meeting in consultation with the ITSGA.

ITEM -1: Roadmap (task) of the ad-hoc committee:

After deliberation the house took following decisions unanimously:

a) Writing of the draft statutes: According to the proposal of the Iran Federation, the 1st draft statutes will be prepared by this federation in collaboration with the president of the Ad-Hoc Committee. This will be done according to the decisions of Ad-Hoc Committee and elements contained in the ITSGA statutes. The final versión of the draft will be discussed in the committee and a formal draft as per statutes of the ITSGA will be prepared for the online meeting of September (Saturday 25-09) and after approval will be send to ITSGA for its kind perusal.

Note: The registration process can be prepared by the Ad-Hoc Committee but only the new elected ATSGA Council will be allowed to register the statutes officially.

b) **Coordination of the event with the organizing committee of the AGM**: The Ad-Hoc Committee will have to get in touch with all candidate organizations. Provisional programme of the event (with a substantial part for TSGs), material conditions, facilities for domestic transportation, etc. will have to be discussed.

c) **Contacts and sending invitations** to the different organizations that will participate to the AGM. Invitations to the list of interested organizations will be done after having been approved by the Ad-Hoc Committee.
