Matt Clifford is the ADA county sheriff. He has 24 yrs. in the department. He is from a small town in ID. The ACSO, Ada county sheriff's office, is the largest local law enforcement agency in ID with nearly 900 employees and more than 400 commissioned deputies. Their main goal is to ensure Ada county is a safe place to live, work and play. The ACSO has 5 bureaus: police services, jail services, court services, administrative, and communications. Their service area is very large and the cities of Eagle, Star and Kuna contract with them. They have one of the largest K -9 units, run a SWAT team (they handle a lot of fugitive apprehensions). They run the properties and evidence for the Boise police. They hire their own mechanics for their fleet services (they are a chevy shop). They have their own HR department. Just to name a few. They want to be out in the community doing other things than catching bad guys so you will see them at safety fairs, national night out, k-9 demonstrations, supporting contract city events and more. They worked very hard to get their dispatchers classified as first responders. It isn't easy answering the many 911 calls received in their center. They go all over the nation to bring people back to ID for their court appearances. Most of the inmates are unhealthy and need medical care. 90% of the inmates are felony offenders. The average length of stay in the jail is 56 days. Consider supporting the Ada county sheriff's youth foundation by purchasing the youth license plate which provides financial support
