



Chapter 5, Page 81 The Chart of Catastrophic Events (based on global past history by special ops personnel)

- 1. Hot civil war / strife / massive violence; think BLM + ANTIFA
- 2. "Engineered Financial Collapse"; think depression, mass unemployment, hyperinflation & massive civil unrest
- 3. Hot civil war and violence from Class Differences in majority Caucasian countries and the United States and because of racial, religious or ethnic differences.
- 4. Worldwide pandemic of genetically engineered human life threatening, or the declaration that it is a life threatening disease.
- 5. Cyber hacking and viruses damaging all or selective area infrastructure control computers creating Critical Life Supplies and Services shortages in specific areas. - 6. Electro-Magnetic Pulse E1/E2/E3-Nuclear Weapon or manmade generated-destroying computers and the electric power grid.
- 7. Solar Electro-Magnetic Pulse E3-Extreme X-Class Solar Coronal Mass Ejection (CME) striking Earth destroying computers and the electrical power grid.
- 8. Famine as a result of decades of Mini Ice Age low temperatures from a Maunder Solar Minimum causing worldwide crop failures Famine also possible from widespread drought, flooding or virulent animal disease and crop fungal/blight problems.
- 9. Disruption of trucking and railroad distribution of Critical Life Supplies and Services because of safety concerns of operators and would primarily affect Metropolitan areas.
- 10. Extreme Nuclear 'dirty bomb' explosion or biological terrorist attack or chemical terrorist attack.
