The Significance of Jerusalem!

The significance of Jerusalem includes many historical and religious teachings. Many of these teachings form the foundation of various religious beliefs while some are categorized as traditions.

Three of the world's major religions trace their steps to the Patriarch Abraham. There are others religions not so widely known with the same foundation. Abraham is considered the first Jewish person. Jewish people are described as descendants of Jacob, sons of Isaac, grandsons of Abraham.

The three major religions that trace their steps to Abraham are Judaism, Islam, and Christianity. Each of these teachings consider Jerusalem to be the holy city. The Temple Mount is one area that all three religions consider to be sacred.

The foundational Biblical text that sets the stage for Jerusalem's significance is Genesis 12:1-3. "Now the Lord had said to Abram, get out of your country from your family and your father's house, to a land that I will show you. I will make you a great nation. I will bless you and make your name great; and you shall be a blessing. I will bless those who bless you, and curse those who curse you: And in you all the families of the earth shall be blessed."

The Jewish faith views the covenant to Abraham as exclusive for them. The capital and most holy city in Judaism is Jerusalem. It has been the spiritual, ancestral, and family background for our Jewish friends since the Abrahamic promise. The first occurrence of the city is mentioned when Abraham bound Isaac on Mt. Moriah. It is in this passage, Genesis 22:2, that Moriah is mentioned. Moriah is one of the mountains in Jerusalem. This is one of the earliest and most significant accounts of Jerusalem.

The city was called Salem. In Genesis 14:18, the city is mentioned as Salem or Shalem. It is mentioned as Jerusalem in Joshua 10:1. The city is the center of the world for the Jewish faith for it is considered that this is where God abides. The city has long been the place of Jewish religious consciousness.

David's desire to capture the city and build the temple there is described in the books of Samuel and a number of the Psalms. Over 800 times in the Hebrew Bible the city is mentioned with renderings including Zion. According to the Hebrew Bible Solomon's temple was built and finished around 950 B.C. In 580 B.C. the Babylonians captured the city and destroyed the temple thereby sending many Jewish families into exile. The Tanakh is the sacred text that contains the written law and is the basis for the oral law which includes the Mishnah and Talmud.

For the Islamic tradition Jerusalem joins Mecca and Medina as sacred sites. It is believed that the prophet Muhammad visited the city. It is therefore the direction for prayers. Muhammad believed himself to be the messenger of God. He proclaimed

himself to be the final prophet of the Judaic-Christian religions. He therefore founded the Islamic faith. The well-observed Dome of the Rock is a sacred shrine. It is here that tradition teaches Muhammad ascended into heaven. For the Islamic faith the most holy place on earth is Saudi Arabia while the most holy spot in Israel is Jerusalem. The mountain is considered the most holy spot in the city.

The Muslims associate with Abraham, David, and a long line of Jewish prophets. Jesus of Nazareth is considered a prophet.

Jerusalem is very important to the Christian because of Yeshua...Yeshua is God in flesh. The New Covenant states, "In the beginning was the Word and the Word was with God and the Word was God. The same was in the beginning with God. All things were made by Him and without Him was nothing made" (John 1:1-3). Jerusalem is seen as the place where Yeshua was in the temple (Luke 2:22). Yeshua attended the festivities in the city. Yeshua appears in the temple cleansing it of the unscrupulous vendors. Yeshua is in the upper room for the last supper while his arrest is in Gethsemane and His crucifixion is actually outside the city at Golgotha. There are two traditional places that are considered to be possibilities of Yeshua's crucifixion and resurrection. One is the church of the Holy Sepulcher and the other is the Garden Tomb at the place of a skull or as it is called "Skull Hill."

Christians view both the Old Covenant and New Covenant to be the inspired Word of God. Judeo-Christian values are considered to be sacred. The city is the most fought over city in history. Jerusalem has been attacked many times. It has been captured and recaptured 44 times. The city was destroyed twice. It is truly the eternal city.

The New Covenant closes with a breathtaking prophecy. "Now I (John) saw a new heaven and a new earth, for the first heaven and the first earth had passed away. Also there was no more sea. Then I John, saw the holy city new Jerusalem coming down from God out of heaven, as a bride adorned for her husband." (Revelation 21:1,2). The city is illustrated as a bride. In this scenario, the bride groom is the highlight. Here, God is dwelling with us. (Revelation 21:13). This expression is a prophecy of a transformation. It will be a transformation to a higher form of living. The heavens and earth will be gloriously renovated and the Messiah will reign supreme. All things will be new! (Rev. 21:5) I believe this Messiah to be Yeshua. He is preparing a place for you. (John 14:1-6).

It is fair to say the most holy place in the world is Jerusalem. The city is where the action is. Religious activity and war are normal occurrences. It is a place to visit over and over again. No city in the world seems to have the significance of this place. It certainly deserves the title "holy city" and we should all "Pray for the peace of Jerusalem, they shall prosper that love thee."
(Psalm 122:6).

WHY PRAY FOR THE PEACE OF JERUSALEM?

Since Jerusalem became a city many years ago, there have been more wars and less peace over this city than in any other city on earth. This special city in God’s plan has been besieged over 40 times in its history.

Even though no other city can come close to all the suffering that has gone on in Jerusalem, we have a special command from God: “*Pray for the peace of Jerusalem...*” Two of the reasons are that God wants to live there and put His Name there:

“...David my servant may have a light always before me in Jerusalem, the city which I have chosen me to put my name there.”
(I Kings 11:36)

This is the city where our Lord chose not only to be crucified for the sins of the world, but it also is the city He is going to return to when He sets up His Kingdom on earth.

ALL NATIONS ARE COMING TO JERUSALEM!

“Behold, I will make Jerusalem a cup of trembling unto all people round about, when they shall be in the siege both against Judah and against Jerusalem. And in that day will I make Jerusalem a burdensome stone for all peoples; all that burden themselves with it shall be cut in pieces, though all the people of the earth be gathered together against it.”
(Zechariah 12:2,3)

You and I now are witnessing the final preparation for yet another and final siege against Jerusalem. Russia along with all its allies are building up their massive armies for the great climatic battle that soon will be fought. Even though there is much talk about peace for the Middle East at this very hour to try and settle the complicated Middle East problem, those who know the Bible know that there will be no lasting peace until Israel’s Messiah comes back to defend Israel and save her from total destruction.

Zechariah clearly tells us what soon will happen when many nations come against Jerusalem:
“...In that day shall the LORD defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem;...And it shall come to pass, in that day, that I

You may be asking the question, “Why is God going to bring all the world to Jerusalem?” He is going to show His Glory!

“And I will pour upon the house of David, and upon the inhabitants of Jerusalem, the Spirit of grace and of supplications; and they shall look upon me whom they have pierced, and they shall mourn for him, as one mourneth for his only son...In that day shall there be a great mourning in Jerusalem...”
(Zechariah 12:10,11)

Yes, Israel finally will see that the “One” who was crucified almost two thousand years ago is their true Messiah; for when He comes back to Jerusalem after the battle of Armageddon, an important question will be answered:

“And one shall say unto him, What are these wounds in thine hands?...His answer will be: “...those with which I was wounded in the house of my friends.”
(Zechariah 13:6)

Those who are still alive in the world also will see why Jerusalem is so important to God. It was there that salvation was wrought by Yeshua, Israel’s true Messiah, and it is there that He will return.

“And His feet shall stand in that day upon the Mount of Olives...and the LORD my God shall come, and all the saints with thee... and the LORD shall be king over all the earth: in that day shall there be one LORD and his name One.”
(Zechariah 14:4,5,9)

Though many nations of the earth have scoffed at the most important spot on the face of the earth, soon they will be brought to Jerusalem to see the Lord magnified:

“Thus will I magnify myself, and sanctify myself; and I will be known in the eyes of many nations, and they shall know that I am the Lord.”
(Ezekiel 38:23)

Do you know this “One,” Yeshua, who soon is going to come and judge the nations? If not, I urge you to learn more about Him so you will not be under God’s judgment, but rather that you can have the peace of God within yourself and have the assurance of being with Him forever.

ISRAEL'S TRUE MESSIAH WILL SAVE ISRAEL & ALSO SAVE YOU!

GOD WILL FIGHT FOR ISRAEL!

Just as Israel is about to be totally defeated, the LORD will fight for Israel as He did so many times in the past. Zechariah describes this in chapter 12:8,9: *"In that day shall the LORD defend the inhabitants of Jerusalem;...And it shall come to pass in that day, that I will seek to destroy all the nations that come against Jerusalem."* Zechariah 14:3,4 describes this defense in greater detail: *"Then shall the LORD go forth, and fight against those nations, as when he fought in the day of battle. And his feet shall stand in that day upon the mount of Olives, which is before Jerusalem on the east,..."*

MOSES SPOKE OF A "LATTER DAY" TRIBULATION AND HE GAVE A SOLUTION!

Moses, who also spoke of a future tribulation, told how the children of Israel could be delivered in the **latter days**: *"But if from thence thou shalt seek the Lord thy God, thou shalt find him, if thou seek him with all thy heart and with all thy soul. When thou art in tribulation, and all these things are come upon thee, even in the latter days..."*

(Deuteronomy 4:29,30)

"If my people, which are called by my name, shall humble themselves, and pray, and seek my face, and turn from their wicked ways; then will I hear from heaven, and will forgive their sin, and will heal their land."

(II Chronicles 7:14)

ISRAEL'S TRUE MESSIAH WILL BE KNOWN BY THOSE WHO SURVIVE!

Israel's true Messiah will be recognized when those who survive call on His name. Zechariah 13:8,9 tells us: *"And it shall come to pass, that in all the land, saith the LORD, two parts therein shall be cut off and die; but the third shall be left therein. And I will bring the third part through the fire, and will refine them as silver is refined, and will try them as gold is tried: they shall call on my name, and I will hear them: I will say, It is my people: and they shall say, The LORD is my God."*

17 PROPHECIES ABOUT ISRAEL'S MESSIAH IN THE HEBREW SCRIPTURES!

1. He would be born in Bethlehem and would come from the tribe of Judah. (Micah 5:2)
2. A messenger would precede His arrival. (Isaiah 40:3)
3. He would ride into Jerusalem on a colt. (Zechariah 9:9)
4. A friend would betray Him. (Psalm 41:9)
5. They would pierce His hands and feet. (Psalm 22:16)
6. His enemies would wound Him. (Isaiah 53:5)
7. To be betrayed for 30 pieces of silver. (Zechariah 11:12)

8. The 30 pieces of silver for His betrayal would be thrown in the Temple of God. (Zechariah 11:13)
9. They would spit on Him and beat Him. (Isaiah 50:6)
10. He remained silent when accused. (Isaiah 53:7)
11. His crucifixion would be among thieves. (Isaiah 53:12)
12. His accusers would gamble for His clothes. (Psalm 22:18)
13. They would pierce His side. (Zechariah 12:10)
14. Not one of His bones would be broken. (Psalm 34:20)
15. There would be no decaying of His body. (Psalm 16:10)
16. He would be buried in a rich man's tomb. (Isaiah 53:9)
17. Darkness would be on the earth the day of the crucifixion. (Amos 8:9)

Though there are many more prophecies that clearly point to the Messiah, **for anyone to fulfill these seventeen prophecies it has been calculated to be 1 chance in 480 Billion x 1 Billion x 1 Trillion!**

NOTE: SEE ISRAEL GET READY! FOR 17 FULFILLED PROPHECIES!

To have sin forgiven, the following steps are key:

FIRST - God wants us to know Him personally, and to have His abundant life. The Scriptures tell us: *"Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. In all thy ways acknowledge Him, and He will direct thy paths."* (Proverbs 3:5,6)

SECOND - One must recognize he is a sinner in need of forgiveness for sin. Abraham recognized this in giving a burnt offering. Isaiah 53:6 says: *"All we like sheep have gone astray; we have turned every one to his own way,..."*

THIRD - One must believe the Scriptures (faith) and must have God's blood sacrifice. Genesis 15:6 states: *"And he (Abraham) believed in the Lord; and He (God) counted it to him for righteousness."* In Leviticus 17:11, Moses said that the blood sacrifice upon the altar makes the atonement: *"For the life of the flesh is in the blood; and I (God) have given it to you upon the altar to make an atonement for your souls; for it is the blood that maketh an atonement for the soul."*

FOURTH - One must believe that GOD'S ONLY PROVISION has been provided by Israel's true Messiah. Through Him, you can experience God's forgiveness and His abundant life.

FIFTH - One must personally repent and believe on Messiah Yeshua (Jesus), receiving Him as Saviour and Lord!

"Messiah Yeshua (Jesus), I confess that I have sinned against You and believe You died for me. I call upon You and open my heart receiving You as my Messiah and Lord. I am willing to follow You as You direct me!"

40 SIGNS OF THE “END TIMES!”



As we face an unknown future for America and Israel, are there any “signs” that may indicate possible climatic events that soon may occur? In Genesis 1:14, we see that God said that certain events that would occur in the heavens would be for “signs and seasons, and for days, and years.” The Hebrew word for “signs” is “Moed” which means divine appointments. Could some of these unusual events show that the appointed time of “Jacob’s Trouble” and Israel’s coming Messiah are about to occur? The following list of 40 SIGNS OF THE “END TIMES!” are important items to consider when thinking on “end time” prophecies. (Scripture references are from both the old and new covenants.)

1. Jewish people would return to Israel and become a new nation. (May 14, 1948) ----- (Luke 21:24, Isaiah 11:11,12)
2. Jerusalem will be under Gentile control until the times of the Gentiles be fulfilled. (June, 1967) ----- (Luke 21:24)
3. Jerusalem to become the burden and concern for the whole world. ----- (Zechariah 12:2,3)
4. All nations on earth will gather against Jerusalem. (UN votes) ----- (Zechariah 14:2)
5. Two-thirds part of Israel will be destroyed in the “end times.” ----- (Zechariah 13:8)
6. One-third part of Israel will be saved and know the Lord. ----- (Zechariah 13:9)
7. Israel’s remnant will look upon the Lord’s pierced hands when He returns. ----- (Zechariah 13:6)
8. Perfect language will be spoken in the last days. ----- (Isaiah 19:18; Zephaniah 3:9)
9. When Zion is built up, the Lord will appear. ----- (Psalm 102:16)
10. There will be “signs” in the sun, moon, and stars! (Star of David, etc.) ----- (Genesis 1:14; Joel 2:31; Luke 21:11, 25)
11. The “generation” that sees the “end time signs” will not pass before the Lord returns. ----- (Luke 21:31-32)
12. Many Jewish people will recognize Messiah Jesus in the last days. ----- (Hosea 3:4,5; Romans 11:25-27)
13. A new Jerusalem Temple will be built in the last days. ----- (Ezekiel 37:26-28; Ezekiel 40-46)
14. Anti-Christ and False Prophet will arise in the “Time of Jacob’s Trouble.” ----- (Revelation 13; Revelation 16:13; 19:20)
15. All who want to buy and sell in the “Great Tribulation” will receive a mark – 666! ----- (Revelation 13:16-18)
16. A one-world religion and a one-world government will be developed in the “end times.” ----- (Revelation 13)
17. The Anti-Christ will sit in the temple of God indicating that he is God. ----- (II Thessalonians 2:3,4)
18. The false Messiah will establish a seven year peace covenant with Israel. ----- (Daniel 9:27)
19. The Lord will defend Israel when all the nations fight against Israel. ----- (Zechariah 12:8,9; Zechariah 14:3,4)
20. A “plague” will be upon Israel’s enemies. ----- (Zechariah 14:12)
21. Many “false” Christs shall arise! ----- (Matthew 24:5)
22. People will scoff at the return of Jesus Christ! ----- (II Peter 3:3,4)
23. When they say, “peace and safety,” sudden destruction will come! ----- (I Thessalonians 5:3)
24. The nations will be in distress with perplexity. (Without resources) ----- (Luke 21:25)
25. Gold and silver to become worthless! ----- (Ezekiel 7:19; James 5:1-3)
26. Weather conditions will intensify with the sea and waves roaring. (El Nino & La Nina?) ----- (Luke 21:25)
27. Men’s hearts will fail for what is coming on the earth. ----- (Luke 21:26)
28. Perilous times will be in the last days and wide-spread lawlessness will increase ----- (Timothy 3:1-5; Matthew 24:12)
29. Drugs used greatly in the last days. ----- (Revelation 9:1; Rev. 21:8; Rev. 22:15)
30. Increase in famines and pestilences (Aids?) ----- (Matthew 24:7)
31. Great increase in knowledge and travel! ----- (Daniel 12:4)
32. Many wars and rumors of wars in the last days. ----- (Matthew 24:6,7)
33. Psalm 83 War could occur before the Ezekiel 38, 39 War? Results in immediate enemies being defeated.--(Psalm 83-1-18)
34. Russia and her allies including Iran will be Israel’s end time enemies. ----- (Ezekiel 38-39)
35. An army of the east numbering 200 million will attack Israel. (China and other eastern nations) ----- (Revelation 16:12-16)
36. Harbingers – God’s warnings! ----- (Isaiah 9:10,11)
37. The downfall of the United States. ----- (Jeremiah 30:11)
38. Worldwide evangelism in the last days! ----- (Matthew 24:14)
39. God will bless those who bless Israel and the Jewish people and curse them that curse the Jew! ----- (Genesis 12:3)
40. God will prosper those that love Jerusalem! ----- (Psalm 122:6)

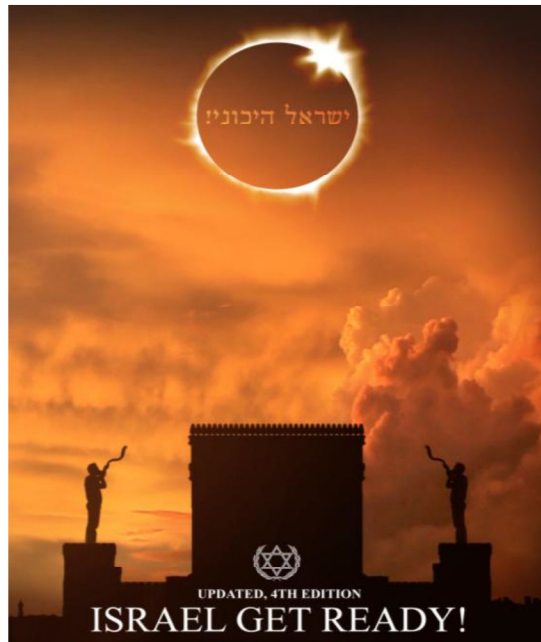
