WHY IS ISRAEL THE APPLE OF GOD’S EYE?

My speech tonight is on the subject of “Why is Israel the Apple of God’s Eye?” The phrase “The Apple of the Eye” is a reference to someone or something that is cherished by others. The term appears in an old English work when King Alfred the Great of Wessex coined the term in 885 A.D. The work was titled Gregory’s Pastoral Care describing the idea. Centuries before this, however, the term appears in Holy Scripture.

The term is a metaphor. A metaphor is a term that applies to something which is not literally applicable. For example, I might say that my grandchild is the “apple of my eye” but I do not literally mean she is an apple in my eye. It is a term of deep endearment.

The apple is a symbol of knowledge. Often an apple is pictured on a teacher’s desk portraying knowledge. Although the apple is not mentioned in the Garden of Eden narrative, it has become a metaphor of temptation and immortality. The apple therefore is a symbol of knowledge, temptation, and immortality.

The eye is considered the most sensitive member of the body. The Hebrew for the apple of the eye refers to the “dark part of the eye.”



The eye includes the cornea, iris, pupil, lens, optic nerve, retina, macula, and vitreous. The eye is extremely sensitive. The eyelids blink. If an eyelid blinks 15-20 times per minute that would amount to over 28,000 times per day. Japan’s Osaka University has done research that indicates the mind is able to rest during the time of blinking.
