TALLAHASSEE - The Florida State Seminoles Baseball Team is holding a donation event to help victims of the recent Hurricane Chris on Friday, September 3rd. The team wants to help the community and is taking donations at Mike Martin Field at Dick Houser Stadium from 8:00 am to 2:00 pm. Individuals and families can contribute by donating items or purchasing merchandise, with all proceeds benefiting the community.

“We are lucky enough to have avoided the effects of Hurricane Chris,” said Head Coach Link Jarret. “However other families were not as lucky, and it is our job to give back to the community that supports us. We hope our team can help the Tallahassee community in any way possible.”

Dick Houser Stadium will serve as the venue where players and coaches will gather to collect donation items. A donation drop-off point will be in Parking Lot 435. Drivers can simply pull up and players will assist in collecting the items. Non-perishable food, water, hygiene items, clothes, and supplies are all accepted.

Merchandise will be available for purchase at several booths, with all proceeds going to support those affected by the hurricane. Clothing items such as jerseys, T-shirts, sweatshirts, and hats are all available for purchase.

"I am so grateful for the team's help," said super-fan Dan Lucas who was affected by the hurricane. "It shows how tightly connected the Florida State community is. We are all here supporting each other, and these hard times truly show it."

All proceeds will go towards the Leon County Disaster Relief Fund. Players will be distributing all collected goods the following day to disaster relief organizations in the Tallahassee area.
