Raised in a family of educators, his passion came naturally, and he used it well by serving the West Feliciana School Board for 41 years. In 2024-2025, two scholarships of \$1500 will be awarded.

### **Eligibility & Selection Criteria for Applicants:**

- Demonstrate a commitment to volunteerism and community contribution.
- Must attend West Feliciana High School and be in good academic standing (A cumulative 2.7 GPA)
- Must be a senior receiving a diploma or high school equivalency diploma (GED).
- A letter of recommendation from a current teacher or advisor (**Preferred**).
- Applicants must enroll as a student at an accredited college/university or a vocational training school in the 2024-2025 school year (Fall Semester). Please include a copy of your acceptance letter from the college/university/vocational school you will be attending.
- Submit a completed scholarship application form no later than **April 4<sup>th</sup>, 2025**.
