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We Are West Fel vs COVID-19 Pandemic

2020—What a year we all experienced! This was something many people had researched, hypothesized, and joked about - something we all hoped would never really happen, but it did. March 13, 2020 I was visiting all the schools (morning, noon, and late afternoon) picking up the annual round of Innovative Teaching Grants. Between the first two rounds and the third, Governor Edwards announced that all public schools were closing in the State of Louisiana until further notice. All of the students and teachers had not yet heard that when I returned for the third round to pick up the grants. I didn't ask—it was evident in the comments of those in the schools. I certainly didn't realize (like most people) just how long this shutdown would last. So many things changed so quickly, and as I am writing this, our state is just now really opening—although some capacities are capped at 50% or 500 people—depending on the event.

We have learned so much this last year about ourselves and our families, about our beliefs, our needs, and what is truly important.

I am so proud to say that at this time, 91% of our students receive their education in person at one of our schools. The other 9% still choose to receive their education in remote fashion. The decision is one that each family has to make according to their own needs and beliefs. I am appreciative that the West Feliciana Parish School System has tried to accommodate each family's preferences for their own students. As a retired educator, I can truly appreciate that learning and teaching remotely is not optimal for most people—especially in a parish where internet access is poor or unavailable for a large portion of our students.

I am proud of all the teachers and administrators who worked so hard to make this happen last spring in a few days time. I am impressed that our school system was able to open for in-person learning in the fall of 2020. Although there were a few glitches and occasions where students and/or teachers had to stay home due to COVID exposure, there were fewer or these instances than I thought there would be. Remote learning was also available for students, if that was the route that the family chose.

Then there were the unprecedented number of hurricane and weather events during 2020—and many of them also impacted the students, teachers, and administrators. There was certainly a lot of trauma and drama this year! The skills the students lost due to all of these things is certainly real.

I have certainly learned to appreciate hugs, gatherings, and other things I took for granted. Because of COVID restrictions, many things changed—and so did the look of this annual report.

Innovative Teaching Grants Awarded in 2020

The following Innovative Teaching Grants were awarded in May, 2020.

As we have done each year since 2016, we invited each educator for West Feliciana Parish Schools to apply for an Innovative Teaching Grant for up to \$2,000. The grants must include the reason and justification for each program. Teachers and/or administrators wrote grants for many different conferences, programs, materials, and equipment. The committee made the decision, due to COVID restrictions, not to fund any grant requiring travel outside of the parish. We did award grants to attend conferences that were attended virtually. Again, because of COVID restrictions, we did not take pictures or talk to students who benefitted from the various grants awarded this year. 
