We hope you will be able to join us for our 2nd Annual Fly-In. We are so thankful to the Jersey Shore Airport in Jersey Shore, Pennsylvania for allowing us to host it at their airport again. If you are planning on attending here are a few things you should know:

- Onsite camping is included in pilot registration this year. Onsite camping is DRY CAMPING (no electricity and no water provided) but generators are welcome.
- Pilot <u>Preregistration</u> is strongly encouraged but not mandatory. This helps us with planning resources (porta-potties, food trucks, etc.) and other event logistics. Preregistration will close on August 15th.
- T-Shirt Preorders will close on July 25th. If you plan on attending and want a t-shirt please preorder. There will be limited onsite t-shirt sales.
- We will make the shirts available for individual orders after the event for anyone that would like one.
- The Jersey Shore Airport is a PRIVATELY OWNED airport and will be an active runway this year. Please be patient with us as we work to manage logistics of approved launch, landing, and camping areas. We will have air bosses helping during busy times.
- We will continue to update social media, the Facebook Event Page, and our Website. Follow us and RSVP to stay up to date.




