- Planning and facilitating programs aligned with the Nova Scotia Before & After Program values and that facilitate growth and development in:
 - Movement & Physical Activity
 - Physical Literacy
 - Outdoor Play
 - Inclusion & Cultural Development
- Actively engaging in programs with children to promote participation
- Ensuring spaces are clean and tidy during programming and at end of day
- Submitting incident reports to supervisor
- Maintaining confidentiality
- Communicate needs to supervisor and/or BAP Facilitator as appropriate
- Maintain positive relationships with teammates, families and other stakeholders
