Presentations:

Financial Update (Year to Date)

The Clerk Treasurer/CAO presented the Income Statement for the New Minas Water Commission as of July 16. At present, the NMWC is reporting the following:

\$148,487 in Revenues (versus \$148,362 last meeting) \$292,276 in Expenses (versus \$281,625 last meeting) (\$143,789) Net (versus \$133,263 last meeting)

The deficit is due mainly to the transfer of Water Commission funds to the Village of New Minas. Approximately \$222,982 of the expenses are annual payments to the Village for the following services for the year:

\$189,640 in Salaries \$5,000 in Benefits \$13,342 in Insurance \$10,000 in LMCC Contribution \$5,000 in Snow Removal \$229,982 Total

The Chair enquired about the revenue generated from Metered Sales and whether the slightly lower sales is a result of COVID-19. Mr. Messom opined that the revenues were based on lower consumption and that more normal usage patterns may emerge after the next quarter.

Mr. Messom provided an overview of the reports prepared by Greatario Services for the Forsythe and Woodvale Water Tanks. The reports were prepared in September 2019. While both tanks are in good condition, maintenance work is required on the latter tank. The report recommends action on maintenance for the Woodvale tank within the next year. Village staff recently discussed the matter with one of its engineering firms, Design Point Engineering and Surveying Ltd. The engineering firm will be preparing a restoration plan for presentation to the Commission in the near future.
