Position: Assistant Head Coach

The Assistant Head Coach will work directly with the Head Coach and Club Manager to oversee the implementation of all club programs. The primary role of the Assistant Head Coach is to directly assist the Head Coach in delivering the U14 & U16+ Sprint Programs. They will also assist in ensuring that all programs are running to their full potential, relating to each program's unique and specific goals and objectives.

Duties:

- In consultation with Head Coach and Club Manager, oversee all club programs and summer staff
- Work with Head Coach to develop and implement U14 and U16+ Sprint programs, including attending all program sessions, regattas, and events
- Work with Head Coach to determine and submit regatta entries
- Assist Head Coach and Club Manager in mentoring and training Junior Coaches
- Assist Head Coach and Club Manager in the coordination of and attend all club related events (pep rally, duck derby, etc.)
- Assist Head Coach and Club Manager with staff performance evaluations to be completed mid-season and post-season
- Assist the Head Coach and Club Manager in ensuring summer staff are completing their regular duties
- Ensure members comply with club safety standards and CPCC Codes of Conduct
- Complete and file incident reports when required
- Complete a season-end program review
