

CPCC Vaccination Policy 2021-2022 Updated October 18, 2021

As of Monday November 1st, 2021, all employees, participants, and members of the CPCC aged 12 and older will be required to provide proof of full vaccination against COVID-19, or proof of medical exemption before gaining permission to enter the clubhouse, office, weight room, or any indoor space used for CPCC program activities.

Please note that to be considered fully vaccinated, the final dose of COVID-19 vaccine must have been received at least 14 days prior to providing proof of being fully vaccinated.

Implementation Procedures

Beginning Monday November 1st, 2021, CPCC staff will be required to confirm proof of vaccination for all employees, participants, and club members prior to granting them access to indoor facilities used for CPCC activities. Employees, participants, and club members will be required to show their vaccine receipt from the Province of Ontario (this can be downloaded through the Province of Ontario's COVID-19 resources website <u>HERE</u>, under 'Proof of Vaccination') before entering indoor facilities for CPCC activities.

The CPCC will not be keeping a copy of the proof of vaccination receipt on file at this time, however we will keep a list of confirmed fully vaccinated individuals for our records. Please note that this process may change with updates from the Ministry of Health.

Medical Exemptions

There are limited instances where individuals will not be required to provide proof of vaccination against COVID-19. Employees, participants, and club members who provide a written document, completed, and supplied by a physician or by a registered nurse in the extended class stating the individual is exempt for a medical reason from being fully vaccinated and the effective time-period for the medical reason, will be considered exempt by the CPCC.
