Position: Camp Programs Coordinator

The Camp Programs Coordinator will work directly with the Head Coach and management team to oversee all CPCC summer camp programs. The primary role of the Camp Programs Coordinator is to ensure the successful planning and implementation of the Canoe Kids and Youth Canoe and Kayak camp programs.

Responsibilities:

- In collaboration with the Head Coach and management team, develop a seasonal plan for both the Canoe Kids and Youth Canoe and Kayak camp programs
- Develop and implement schedules and creative daily activity plans for all CPCC camp programs
- Communicate professionally with parents, participants, and management team (welcome emails, replying to parent inquiries, telephone communications, etc.)
- Assess camp participants regularly
- Provide weekly feedback to program participants and parents
- Collaborate with junior staff and club management to ensure camp facilities and equipment are clean and in good working order
- Track and monitor campers daily sign-in/sign-out procedures and attendance
- Manage, mentor, and support Summer Camp Counselors daily
- Ensure camper compliance with the club safety standards and CPCC Code of Conduct
- Attend all staff training sessions & assist in training camp counselors
- Attend weekly staff meetings
