Head Coach and Technical Director's report

The club had a very busy and successful year. Full return to competition made things very busy but well received among members. Grassroots to High Performance programming was almost back up to full capacity and engaging paddlers enjoying the river again. Thanks to Alessandra for the time and effort she put into grants so that we can continue to support programming, two Trillium grants, Canada Summer Jobs, Canadian Tire Jump Start to name a few.

U14 and U12 home CP regatta, 212 athletes attended in July. Fallapalooza saw 85 athletes attend this training camp.

Trillium foundation grant contributed to being able to hire program manager Ellie Lanouette to support with club administration.

Sprint programs increased approximately 19% in 2022. Great results in

performances. U10 to Petrie and Gananoque, U12 to regional competitions, U14 and U16 athletes did well at provincials and nationals. Twenty-one athletes at Nationals and 41 to Provincials. One athlete at Sr. World Championships, silver medalist. One athlete to Canada summer games. One athlete represented Canada at World Championships- Marathon.

Return to full day camp programs. We hit capacity and were able to add an extra week to camp program at the end of the summer.

Paddle All-13 participants, on par with pre-covid numbers. Will continue to attempt to grow this program.

New coming next year-Dragon boat and other paddle sports.
