Position: Canoe Kids and Youth Canoe/Kayak Camp Counsellor(s)

The Summer Camp Counsellor(s) will work with the Camp Programs Manager to provide a safe, fun, and developmentally appropriate program environment for the Canoe Kids and Youth Canoe/Kayak Camp participants.

Duties:

- Assist in the coordination and implementation of the Canoe Kids and Youth Canoe/Kayak Camp programs (including scheduling & planning activities)
- Ensure participants are signed in/out safely each day of programming
- Attend all staff training sessions
- Work in collaboration with the Camp Programs Manager to implement creative and innovative camp program
 activity plans and assess participants regularly

- Communicate consistently and professionally with camp program parents/guardians (at pick-up and drop-off)
- Work with peers to ensure camp equipment and facilities are prepared and clean for each day of programming
- Assess camp participants regularly
