

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

NARRATIVE STATEMENT

On June 22, 2014, Logan Gonzales-Romero (2-year-old) was outside playing in the 2200 block of Parkville Court, Columbus, Franklin County, State of Ohio. After getting ice cream from a parked ice cream truck, mom, Logan, and older brother were walking back to their home. Logan went in between 2 parked cars, out into the street, and was struck by a passing pizza delivery vehicle.

The pizza delivery driver stated he did not see the little boy as he was walking through the parking lot. Logan's mother rushed the child to St. Ann's Hospital where he was then transported by medical helicopter to Nationwide Children's Hospital. Unfortunately, due to the nature of the injuries Logan sustained, he lost his life.
