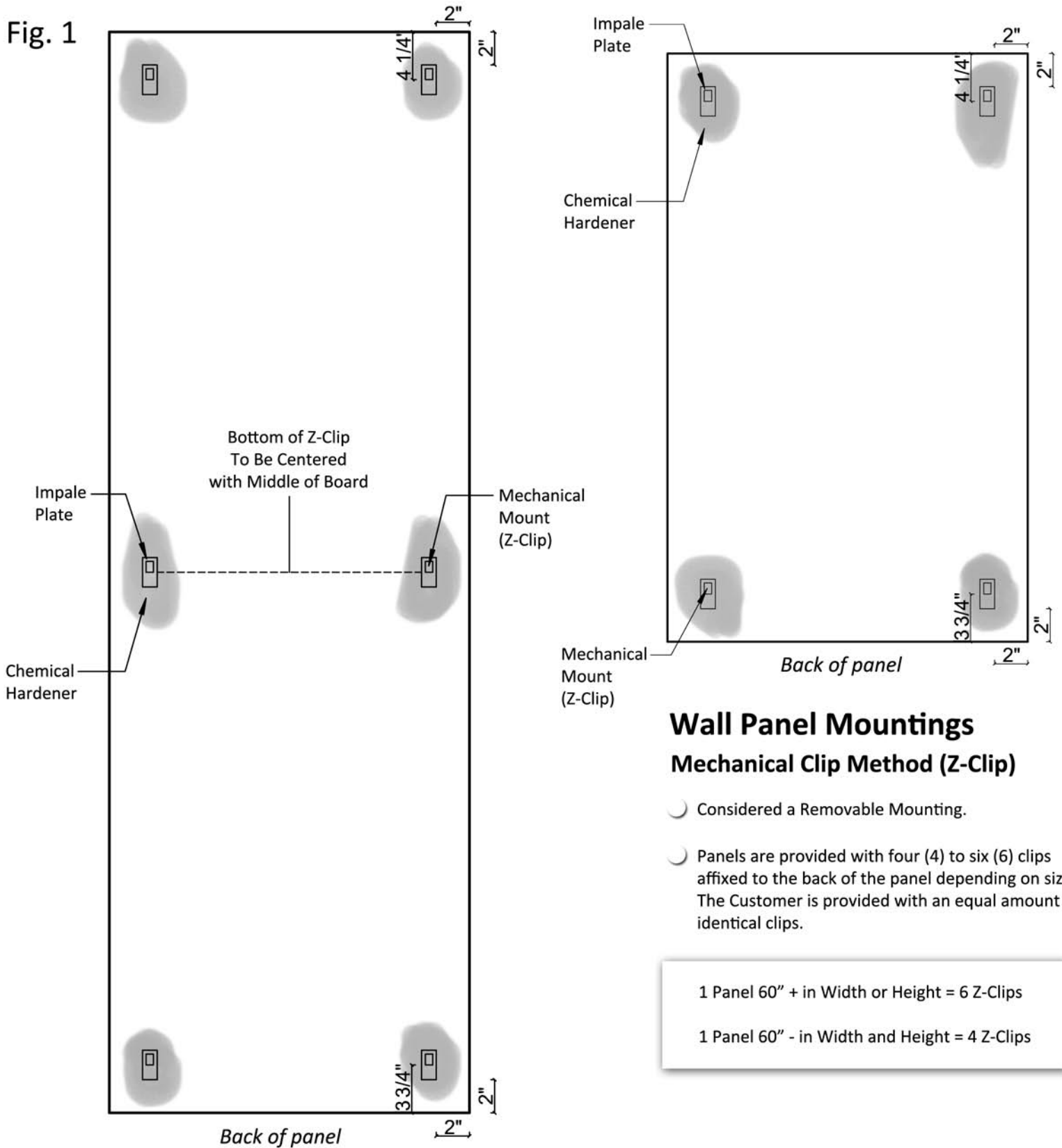

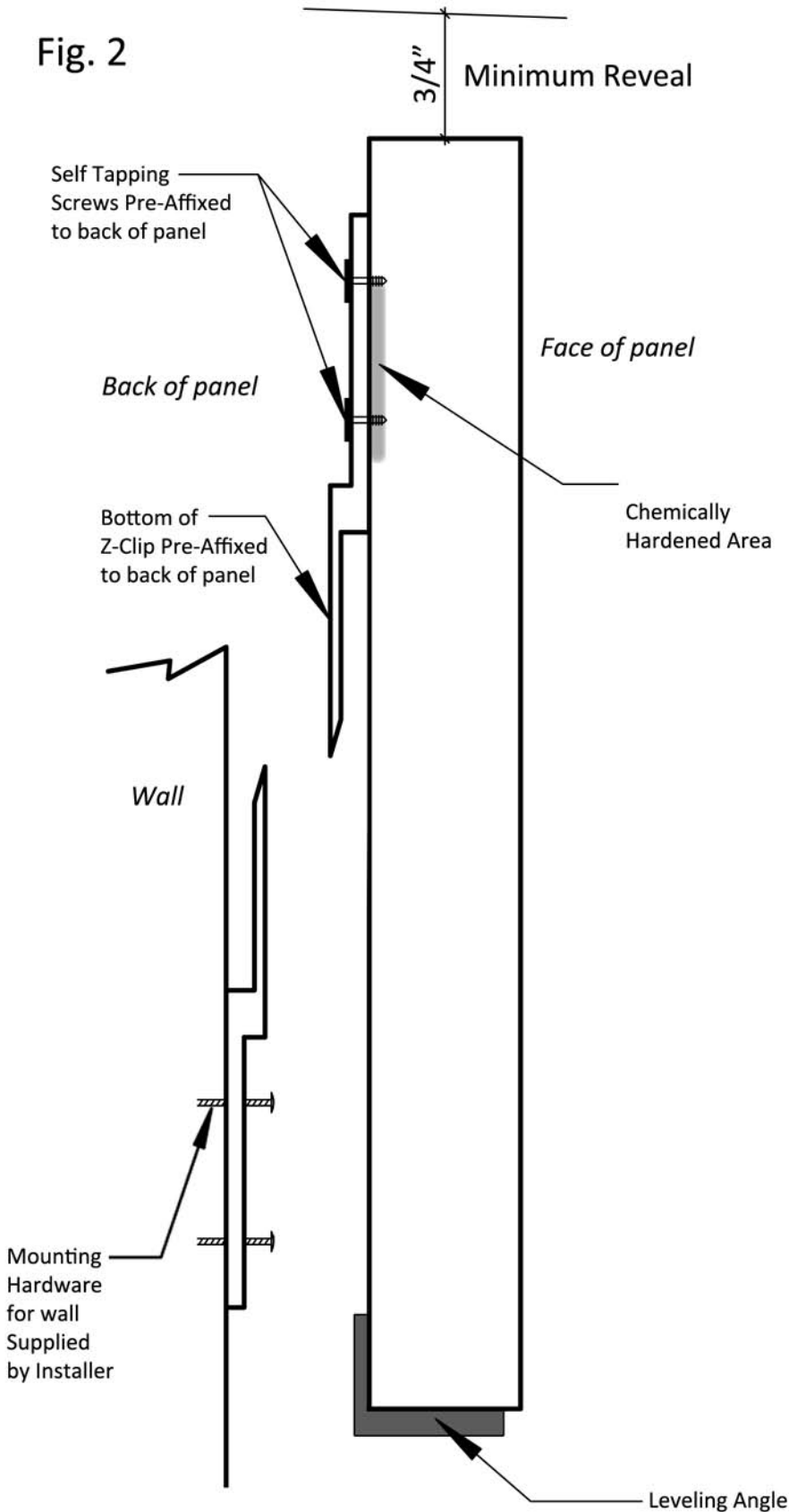


Wall Panel Mountings Mechanical Clip Method (Z-Clip)

- Considered a Removable Mounting.
- Panels are provided with four (4) to six (6) clips affixed to the back of the panel depending on size. The Customer is provided with an equal amount of identical clips.

1 Panel 60" + in Width or Height = 6 Z-Clips
 1 Panel 60" - in Width and Height = 4 Z-Clips

Mechanical Clip Method (Z-Clip)

- Installing panels with mechanical clips will require a minimum of 3/4" reveal from top of panel to ceiling. This reveal is necessary to allow the clips to interlock.
- For best results, installers should use a template to locate clips mounted on walls.
- When projects require many different size panels, the customer may specify clip locations on panels for ease of installation.
- With the mechanical clip mounting, acoustical panels are normally about 1/4" off of walls. This should be anticipated where panels run into doors, windows and at inside and outside corners.
- A leveling angle should always be used at the bottom edge of panels to ensure a true, level, line-up of panel edges.

1 Panel 60" + in Width or Height = 6 Z-Clips

1 Panel 60" - in Width and Height = 4 Z-Clips
