December Block of the Month Country Stars

This quilt is made with four different blocks. All the blocks are either a snowball or a 9-patch but the color placement will create the pattern. We will make two different blocks in December and then in January make two more different blocks. The white and light red fabric will be provided by the guild. One packet in December and different packet in January.

9-Patch-December

Cut five 2 ½" squares with blue fabric. Using the four white squares provided make a 9-patch following color placement in diagram A.

Snowball-December

Use the 6 ½" white square provided and the two light red 2 ½" squares. Cut from your own fabric two 2 ½" blue squares.

Place the red squares on two corners of the large square and two blue squares on the opposite corners. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of each of the small squares. Sew on the line, cut ¼" away and press fabric towards the outside of the block. See diagram B and C.
