

February Block of the Month

Friendship Chain

To make this block members will use all their own fabric.

Light cream colored fabric- cut two-5" squares and eight 2 ½" squares

Black tone on tone- cut eight 2 ½" squares

Bright Jewel Tone- cut two 5" squares and one 4 ½" square. The 4 ½" square should be a darker tone than the 5" squares but same color. This will make the quilt visually prettier and have movement.

- 1- Use the cream colored and jewel tone 5" squares to make four 1/2 square triangles.

Draw a line diagonally on the light fabric, place right sides together. Sew ¼" on each side of line, cut on the line and press toward the dark color.

Square up the ½ square triangles to 4 ½".

- 2- Using the black and cream 2 ½" squares make four 4-patches

- 3- Sew all the sections together following the picture.
