

Bargello Quilt  
Adaptation to free pattern "Rippling Flags from Windhamfabrics.com



FABRIC: ½ yd EACH of ten (10) fabrics- lay out in pleasing order

1. Label BOTH diagrams with your fabric colors
2. Cut four (4) 4" width of fabric (at least 40") strips of EACH fabric
3. Make (2) strip set X and (2) strip set Y. Take care that one end is even ( depending on your fabric choices the other end may be uneven. Be sure the shortest fabric in EACH set is at least 40"
4. Press seams in direction of arrows (original pattern does not press seams, but I find it makes it neater)

SUPPLIES:

1. Machine, thread, etc.
2. Cutting mat, long ruler, rotary cutter
3. Numbered pins OR pins and paper (I have numbered pin sets for \$5, contact me if you want a set)
4. Iron, ironing board or mat
