Supply List for Members

Fabric – White 100% cotton – no permanent press or other processes

Fat quarters for general ice dye

1 – 2 yards for geode pattern

Bins – dish pans, aluminum roasting pans, tubs (Dollar Tree)

Latex gloves – at least two pairs

Bag of ice (we will bring more ourselves, but we want to be sure to have more than enough ice)

NOTE: If you have a large cooler, please bring it so we can keep the ice cold

*Garbage bags – at least kitchen size that each bin can fit in for the trip home (or like Lois, you may end up with dyed auto carpet)

*Zip lock bags – gallon size (Dollar Tree) – one for each piece of fabric

*= the bags will be used depending on how fast the ice melts

Bag Lunch and Drink

Jen and/or Lois will bring

Screens

Plastic spoons

Spring clips

Rubber bands

Soda Ash for pre-treating fabric

Dye – many different colors

Ice

PRE-SOAK

We'll be doing the pre-soak in soda ash as the very first step.

Your fabric will be placed in the pre-soak tubs.

On each piece of fabric with a Sharpie marker or indelible pen, please put your initials in a fabric corner (tiny letters)

Let's all hope for warm sunny weather; but we'll do this rain or shine!
