Mystery Quilt 2021

"Stars and Stripes"
Quilt size finished 61"x 73"
Block Size 12"

Materials:

1 yard of dark fabric for blocks, this fabric should be your darkest.

1 yard of dark fabric (print #1) for blocks and binding

1 1/8 yards dark fabric (print #2) for outer border

1 1/8 yards of medium for blocks and inner border

3/4 yard light for blocks

The first five fabrics should be variations of the same color.

3/4 yard of a complimentary color.

1 1/4 yards background (#3) for blocks

1 ¼ yards background (#4) for blocks

3 ¾ yards for backing fabric

The first set of directions for the mystery quilt is to choose two colors that look good together, one is predominant while the other provides a pop of color.

The majority of the fabric for the quilt is one color, shades of that color from dark, medium to light. The blocks have two different backgrounds that should coordinate with all the fabrics. You can make your background fabric throughout the quilt, one fabric, if you prefer.

To start: either buy your fabric or use from your own fabric stash. "Stars and Stripes" is the name of the quilt, but do not be fooled by the title, any color combination would work with this quilt.
