Lorraine talked about the quilt for the grand prize for the Bingo and asked for \$80.00 to be spent on backing and batting. Sheri Seip motioned to spend \$80. and Judy Miehl seconded it. All were in agreement. Bingo quilts are due at the June 14th meeting. Challenge Committee- we were asked to work on Challenge and it will be hung at the library. Challenge Ouilts are due March 15th. Founders Award was discussed and a description of the qualities of an honoree will be passed out at next meeting. The guild was informed of Charity guilts by Lorraine. Blocks were put together at Saturday's workshop. Batting is needed for the quilts and best price was at Joanns for \$200. 00. Lorraine motioned that we spend \$200.00 for the batting and Judy Miehl seconded. The guild was in agreement. Community service projects were discussed. Meals on Wheels would like donated 12 x 18 inch placemats. Marie Guidry talked about donating 100 pillowcases to VFW Veterans Hospital and nursing home. More pillowcases are needed. Some Wednesday nights at the Library are available for the guild to make blocks for Quilts of Valor. Please check the newsletter. Thank you to Hospitality who helped with the delicious refreshments. A retreat in Fall at the Comfort Inn in Lancaster, PA was presented. Cost was \$145. for the weekend plus the hotel cost. More to come later if interested.


Quilt Bingo
