

Nominating Committee

Our By Laws state we need to form a nominating committee in May. All officers serve a one year term, so elections are held each July. Mary Santoro has agreed to be the Board representative but we also need two members to volunteer to be on the committee. I will be looking for volunteers at the May meeting.

Activities:

June 17: Quilting Fellowship Day:

Name Tag Workshop: The following are supplies for the workshop: Scissors, wonder under, pencil, marker, sewing machine, pin back (will be supplied by the guild), 6X 6 piece of batting, fabric for your name tag colors of trees, water, mountains, grass, and sky. Fabric for backing and the background of the name tag. If possible please download your NAME TAG PATTERN from the PMQG WEB SITE. Questions call Peggy <u>570 856 1844</u>.

Placemats: Kits will be available to make place mats for "Meals on Wheels", everything you will need to make the place mat will be provided. A quick method for sandwiching and turning will be shown, no need for binding!

Batik Cutting Bee: We currently have 10 members signed up for the cutting bee. The sign-up sheet will be available at the May meeting. We originally discussed cutting the fabric into 2 1/2 " and 4 1/2" strips but we are changing it to just 2 1/2" strips. This should prevent any confusion with how many of each strip to cut. 2 1/2" strips can be used for a much greater number of patterns including jelly roll patterns. The fabric requirement will remain the same - 10 half yard pieces of batiks fabric (total 5 yards). We are requesting all fabric be washed prior to cutting. We are encouraging members to bring fabric and cutting supplies to the June 17th Fellowship Day and we can all cut fabric as a group and then exchange. Each 1/2 yard cut will be cut into 7- 2 1/2" strips. Try to bring a variety of light, medium and dark fabrics. The more people who participate the greater the variety of batiks each will go home with.

We will have a pot luck lunch that day, so please bring food to share with fellow quilters. There will be a sign up sheet at the May Business Meeting.

Fat Quarter Basket: Please bring your fat quarters to the guild meetings; we need more fat quarters at this time. Thank you in advance. *Submitted by Sheri Seip*

BOM/Charity Quilts:

Many thanks to those of you who came to our Charity Work Session the other week: Laura Lyman, Sheryl Flatt, Lorraine Hare, Kathy Parrish, Sarah Pierson, Peggy P. Chiniewicz, Judy Mehl and Ana Rivera.

We joined QOV BOM blocks to make three quilt tops and cut fabric to make additional "Next Door Neighbor" blocks to complete another top. We will piece those blocks at the May meeting. Laura has since added an inner border and prepped pieces for an appliqué border on the Indian Hatchets quilt and completed a border on both the Rail Fence and Road to Oklahoma quilts. Both of those quilts will go out to be long-arm quilted as soon as they are assigned.

We also awarded the completed "Star and Crown" quilt to the husband of one of our regular QOV BOM sewers from the Mountain Laurel Guild. She promised to send pictures soon. Thank you to all who have made QOV BOM blocks, these quilts are greatly appreciated by the recipients.

I'd like to ask all of you who took home Charity tops to quilt, please complete one top by our next meeting. Remember, simple quilting is fine, just be sure to do more than stitch-in-the-ditch as these quilts will be donated to Pleasant Valley Manor and will be washed frequently. Thank you and great work!
