MATERIALS for Medium Size:

Sewing Machine

Basic Sewing Machine Supplies

Fabric:

Print A – Six (6) 2 ½” x 6” strips

Print B – Six (6) 2 ½ x 6” strips

Two (2) 2 ½” x 10 ½” strips

One (1) 1 ½” x 4” strip

Lining (can be of either of above fabrics or different) – Two (2) 9” x 11” strips

Fusible Fleece – Two (2) 10 ¾” x 8 ¾” strips

Trim for top of bag (22” strip is fine) or buttons (6 or 8)

Notions:

One 12” zipper or longer (whatever you have)

Matching thread

Note from Vicki: I showed these at the June meeting for the Bingo Tricky Tray and will also bring some to our picnic meeting. These are fast and fun to do...make great gifts, too! I have embroidered on the tops to personalize as well.

Fabric Exchange

The fabric squares will be exchanged at the August meeting. You will have to cut **60 five inch squares. To be able to cut 30 5" squares you will need 5/8 of a yard of fabric.** The squares do not to be cut from all the same fabric, it is fine to use your scraps. There are many quilt designs using 5" squares.

There will be a group for **Black/Red** and a group for **Yellow/Blue**, (the yellow will be a sunshine yellow and the blue a delft blue, do not use light blues or navy).


