#### April minutes 4/24/21

The meeting was called to order at 1:10 following a fellowship gathering. There were 25 members present. Kathy Parrish presided. The PMQG insurance policy was briefly discussed and updates in regards to meeting sites had been updated. Elections for officers for the 2021-2022 year will require a nominating committee in May and members were asked to consider volunteering in this capacity. Most of our current Board have held their positions for more than 2 years due to extensions approved due to CoVid. It was announced that there was a vacancy for the Sunshine committee person and Ana Rivera agreed to step in. The Secretary's minutes for the March meeting was printed in the newsletter.
