

## SCAVENGER HUNT CHALLENGE

**START:** January meeting

**FINISH:** July meeting

**RULES:** Bring to the January meeting 5 (five) different items that you have hunted for in a sealed brown paper bag. These items should be able to be used in the making of a quilted piece. **Suggestions:** fabric (at least ½ yard), lace, buttons, rick rack, fabric panel, ribbon, beads, cut off savage edges, binding, item you bought for a quilt project and will never finish, etc. You get the idea. These are only suggestions, let your imagination run wild.

List these items on the index card that is attached to the instruction sheet and place along with the items in the bag.

**CONTINUE:** You now have your bag with the scavenger hunt items inside .At the January meeting these bags will be numbered and placed together. Then you will choose one with the items you will use to make your quilted piece.

### **DIRECTIONS:**

1. Three (3) of the items in the bag **MUST** be used, but all five may be used. Mark the items used on the index card found in the bag and attach to the piece when finished. On the back of the index card put your name and phone number.
2. Any number of additional fabrics or notions may be used.
3. There is no size requirement.
4. Any item such as clothing, bags, accessories, table runners, wall hangings and bed quilts may be made.
5. Piece must be quilted.
6. Piece must be made by quilt member.
7. Piece must have a label attached with name and phone number and covered with fabric.

**JUDGING:** Judging will be based on: Creativity, workmanship, use of scavenger items supplied, (the number of items used adds to total number added to score, 3 items 3 points, 4 items 4 points, 5 items 5 points) and originality. Winners will be determined according to the entries.

Please keep this instruction sheet to use as a reference sheet. It is important to make sure you have followed the steps listed.

Have fun, use your imagination, and lets all make this a group challenge to show case our special talents at the August picnic meeting.
