## Sawtooth Star Block

## Cutting for the 12" Star

From Background Fabric:

Cut 1, 3 1/2-inch strip.
From that strip cut 4, 3 1/2" x 6 1/2" rectangles and 4, 3 1/2" squares

From the Star Points Fabric:

· Cut 8, 3 1/2-inch squares

For the star center you will use the 6 1/2-inch star block

## Piecing

Step 1 Position a 3 1/2-inch star points square on the corner of a  $3 \frac{1}{2}$ "  $\times$  6  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Draw a diagonal line on the square and stitch on this line. Trim the seam allowance to  $\frac{1}{4}$ -inch, and press. Repeat this process at the opposite corner of the rectangle. Make 4.













Step 2 Sew a Step 1 unit to the top and botton of the 6 1/2-inch square (or small star block) and press. Sew the remaining 3 1/2-inch squares to both ends of the remaining Step 1 units. Sew these units to the sides of the star block and press. The block should measure 12 1/2-inches.
