Fabric Exchange:

Members may participate in a fabric exchange to make circles to make Drunkard's Path quilt. The fabric is due next month and will be sorted the same night and returned to the participant. What you need is:

- **40** pieces of fabric **10**", no more than 8 of the same fabric.
- **40** pieces of fabric **7**", no more than 8 of the same fabric.

Colors requested are: light or dark blue, light or dark green, light, medium and dark beiges, red but no pinks, golds but no yellows. Use tone on tone, solids, small/medium prints, plaids, stripes, homespuns are okay. Please avoid batiks, patriotic, holiday and juvenile prints.

Put your fabrics in a bag with your name on them. Ideas will be shown to easily make your block. Bring finished quilt or completed top to the September Meeting.


