

October Block of the Month

Stepping Stone

For each block from a true white on white fabric cut : two $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ squares, two $6\frac{1}{2}" \times 2"$ strips, two $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 2"$ rectangles, and four $2" \times 2"$ squares.

From a medium blue fabric cut one $3\frac{1}{2}" \times 3\frac{1}{2}"$ square and eight $2" \times 2"$ squares.

Sew a $2"$ blue square to each end of a $6\frac{1}{2}"$ strip. Repeat to make a second unit.

Join a $2"$ blue square to each end of a $3\frac{1}{2}"$ white rectangle. Then sew a second $2"$ white square to each end. Repeat to make a second unit.

Sew $3\frac{1}{2}"$ white square to opposite sides of a $3\frac{1}{2}"$ blue square.

Piece the 5 units as shown to complete the block. Block should measure $9\frac{1}{2}" \times 9\frac{1}{2}"$.
