Under the Oklahoma Open Records Act, I, Christopher J. Barnett hereby request a full and complete list of all licensed growers, processors and dispensaries as well as the addresses, owners names and phone numbers for all growers, dispensaries, and processors who have been licensed by the State of Oklahoma.

It is my understanding that the OMMA has removed this information from its website, violating the Oklahoma Open Records Act. I request that the Oklahoma Department of Public Health restore this information to the OMMA website as it is public record and the OMMA has no authority to censor or keep this information from the public, even citing safety concerns. For example, liquor stores have been robbed in Oklahoma, and even people working at liquor stores have been killed, but liquor store information, as well as the owners name is available to the public.

The Oklahoma Department of Public Health must provide all information and cannot censor or shield it.

Please provide the information requested and please consult with your legal counsel. The Oklahoma Department of Public Health cannot keep this information private or only provide part of it.

I request the most recent, up to date list for all information with a start date of July 01, 2018 to current. The form provided on the OMMA website is defective and does not allow you to put a date for starting from other than the current date. This must also be corrected immediately. It is not required under Oklahoma Law that I fill out any form to obtain access to Oklahoma Public Records.

This information is requested in the interest of the public and on behalf of the public watch dog group Transparency for Oklahoman's. We publish this list on our website, and will update it weekly, or as often as possible, because it is of interest to the public and the public has the right to know. The list is openly available here

The Oklahoma Department of Public Health and the OMMA can save tax payers money by restoring this list to its website with ALL information, otherwise the Oklahoma Department of Public Health will have to continue to full fill the same open records request each week.
