Dear Mr. Oakley

We are expanding our investigation into the City of Bixby and the Bixby Police Department.

On behalf of Transparency for Oklahoman's, I hereby submit my open records request to you requesting the following information, in the interest of the public:

Any and all e-mails sent or received for the email address soakley@bixbyok.gov for the time period of 01/01/2017 to current. If you have used any other City or personal emails conducting any City of Bixby or discussing any City of Bixby Police business, please provide those emails as well. If you claim an Attorney Client exemption applies, we respectfully request that you provide a log of what you claim is exempt and then we will ask a Judge to determine what is and is not exempt. It is likely we will need to ask a Judge to appoint a discovery master.

This information is being obtained in the interest of the public after you disclosed on a recorded phone call with me that you and the police chief have personal communications via your tax payer email addresses.

The public has the right to see if you are actually conducting city business, or if you are using your email address for other purposes.

Additionally, I request all text messages sent or received from your phone(s) that discuss any city of Bixby or Bixby Police business.

Under the Oklahoma Open Records Act, you may not ask why I am seeking this information as you did earlier. I have made it very clear that my request is in the interest of the public and in this case, it appears that we have city officials mis-using public property at the expense of tax payers.

Please provide all documents in electronic format if possible. I am happy to pay for any CD or DVD's or any USB drives that they are put on. Per Oklahoma Law, no search fee shall be charged.

If you, or the Police Chief have a City of Bixby Credit Card issued, I request the last 12 billing statements with a starting period of December 18, 2017 to current.

Our IT expert has said this request will not cause an excessive disruption to your everyday operations and should take only a few hours to full fill.

If you have abused your position, or have used your city email address for personal use, it may be cause to seek your resignation or firing, or a Grand Jury investigation into the matters, along with the Bixby Police Chiefs emails as well.
